Good Morning,

Our average response time for primary coverage areas is 5 minutes and 9 seconds. In the Southern Region specifically that number is 4 minutes and 43 seconds. This is due to the geography of the South and the number of units we are staffing in a smaller area when compared to the central. On average, patients reach the hospital in under 32 minutes from calling 9-1-1 in the Southern Region.

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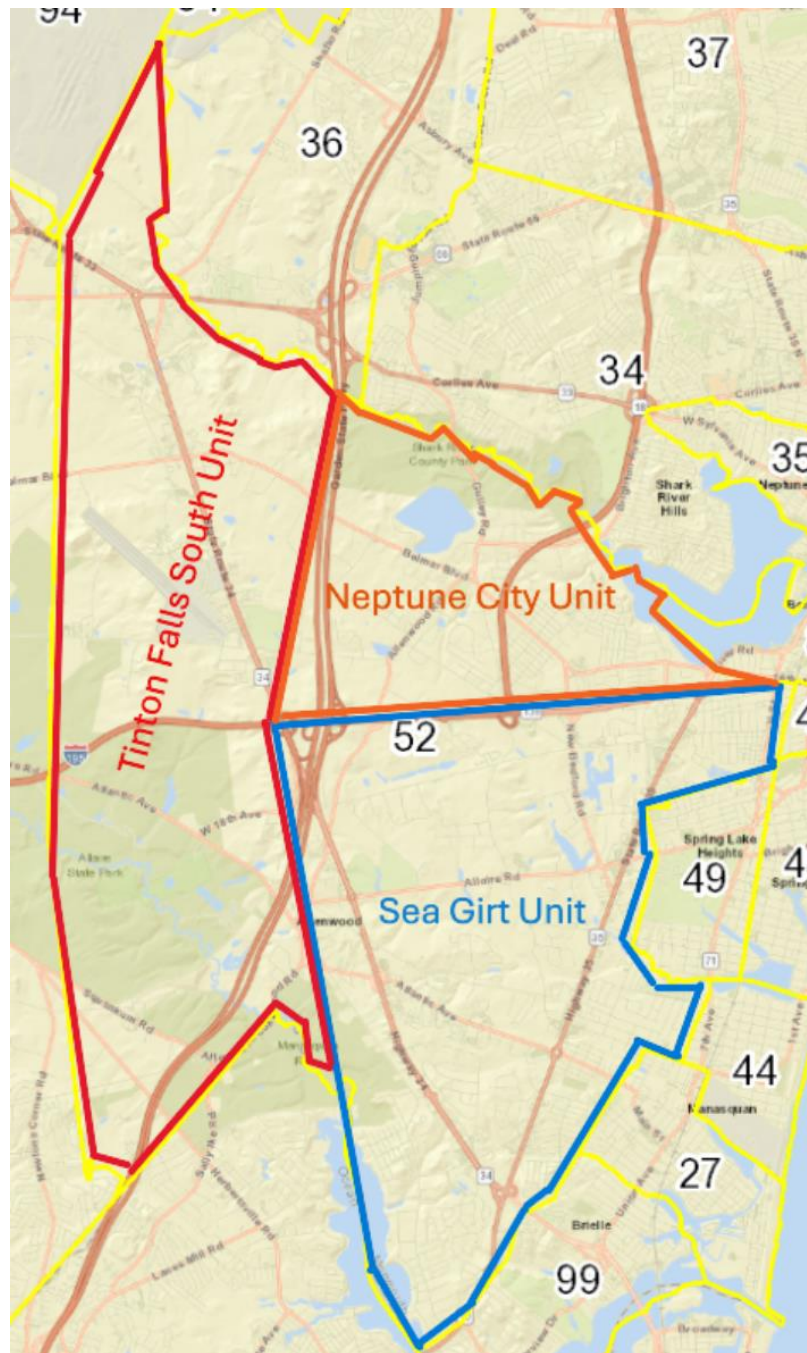

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Emergency Medical Services
Mutual Aid Agreement

This Agreement is made and entered into effect on the 11th day of June, 2025 through July 2030, and may be extended for an additional five (5) years with mutual consent of parties between the TOWNSHIP OF WALL, (hereinafter referred to as "Wall Township EMS") and the COUNTY OF MONMOUTH (Hereinafter referred to as "MedStar").

WHEREAS, Wall Township EMS and MedStar recognize the necessity to cooperate and work together to provide mutual aid and contingency assistance to the surrounding communities and at times may need to receive the same assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall passed Resolution 2025-0606 at its June 11, 2025 meeting which authorized the Township of Wall to enter into this Shared Services Agreement with the COUNTY OF MONMOUTH for the provision of Emergency Medical Services pursuant to N.J.S.A 40A:65-1 *et. seq.*, the Uniform Shared Services; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BY AND AMONG THE GOVERNING BODIES WHO HAVE DULY EXCUTED THIS AGREEMENT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 – Definitions:

As used herein:

- A. "Emergency Medical Services," means a service engaged in providing initial emergency medical assistance on a Basic Life Support level.
- B. "Mutual Aid," means the preplanned and organized response of emergency medical services, to a request for assistance in an emergency when local resources have been expended.
- C. "Mutual Aid Plan," means a written Agreement between two or more jurisdiction which list responding agencies, personnel, and equipment.
- D. "Emergency Response Area," means geographical boundaries used to define emergency medical services response capability by one or more EMS agencies. This can be EMS districts, township boundaries or any other area defined by local statute or contract Agreements.

Section 2 – Mutual Aid Agreement

- A. Wall Township EMS and MedStar mutually agree to provide mutual aid EMS services to each other which may include but not limited to the following reasons:
 - a. Pending Emergency Medical Calls

- b. Large Scale Incident (MCI) in which additional resources may be needed.
 - c. Stand-by for an event that may require additional units to cover as long as advances notice is given.
- B. The members of Wall Township EMS and MedStar may at times conduct coordinated and joint training sessions together to ensure inter agencies relationship and understanding.
- C. The EMS Managers of these programs will maintain contact to assure that the spirit of this Agreement is maintained to the mutual benefit of both entities.

Section 3 – Equipment

The final decision on the amount and type of equipment to be sent shall be based on availability of EMS units to still provide day to day care for its own Township and/or County services. Neither party to this agreement shall make any claim whatsoever against the other for refusal to send the requested personnel or equipment where such refusal is based on the lack of availability of services and/or equipment.

Section 4 – Terms of Agreement

This Agreement shall be in full force and effect upon execution by each party hereto. This Agreement shall remain in effect for an unlimited timeframe and reviewed on an annual basis. Cancellation by any party must be given with sixty-day written notice.

Section 5 – No Reimbursement for Cost

Neither party shall seek reimbursement from each other for services that are provided. Each shall pay its own cost (i.e. salaries, repairs, material, compensation, etc.) for responding for requests for mutual aid.

Section 6 – Fees for Ambulance

Agencies providing ambulance transport or other services normally billed for shall be entitled to their normal fees for services and are responsible for their own billing, insurance filing and collection activity.

Section 7 – Indemnification

Each responding party hereby waives all claims against each party for compensation for any and all property loss or damage and/or personal injury or death occurring as a consequence of the performance of this Agreement.

MedStar shall save and hold the Wall Township EMS, its officers, employees, elected officials and/or agents harmless from and against all liability, damage, loss, claim, demands and actions of any nature whatsoever, which arises out of, or are connected with or are claimed to arise out of or connected with the services provided by the Wall Township EMS. MedStar shall indemnify,

defend and hold the Wall Township EMS, its officers, employees, attorneys, agents or representatives, volunteers, successors and assigns, harmless from and against any claims, causes of action, costs, expenses, damages or liability that are asserted against the Wall Township EMS in connection the services provided under this Agreement. Without limitation of the foregoing, MedStar shall further indemnify and hold harmless the Wall Township EMS from and against any and all losses, costs or damages (including reasonable attorney's fees) with respect to any breach of any warranty or representation herein or its breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement, and all Third Party Claims of liability arising from or pertaining to the services undertaken by the Wall Township EMS for the residents of MedStar by the Wall Township EMS, its employees, volunteers, agents, representatives or contracted professionals.

LIKEWISE:

The Wall Township EMS shall save and hold the MedStar harmless from and against all liability, damage, loss, claim, demands and actions of any nature whatsoever, which arises out of, or are connected with or are claimed to arise out of or connected with the services provided by MedStar. The Wall Township EMS shall indemnify, defend and hold MedStar, its officers, employees, attorneys, agents or representatives, volunteers, successors and assigns, harmless from and against any claims, causes of action, costs, expenses, damages or liability that are asserted against MedStar in connection the services provided under this Agreement. Without limitation of the foregoing, the Wall Township EMS shall further indemnify and hold harmless MedStar from and against any and all losses, costs or damages (including reasonable attorney's fees) with respect to any breach of any warranty or representation herein or its breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement, and all Third Party Claims of liability arising from or pertaining to the services undertaken by MedStar for residents of the Wall Township EMS by MedStar, its employees, volunteers, agents, representatives or contracted professionals.

Section 8 – Insurance

Each party shall procure and maintain such insurances as is required by applicable federal and state laws and as may be appropriated and reasonable to cover its staff, equipment, vehicles, and property, including but not limited to liability insurance, workers' compensation, unemployment insurance, automobile liability, and property damage.

The parties hereby agree that the Wall Township EMS and MedStar shall maintain property insurance on all facilities and vehicles that may be affected by the services of the Agreement, with each party providing a Certificate of Insurance to the other naming each party as additional insured. Each party shall provide proof of insurance and maintain their own liability insurance and personal property insurance for any loss or damages arising from services provided and shall provide each other with a Certificate of Insurance, naming both as additional insured. All parties shall maintain a sum of no less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for property loss and One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for liability for injuries resulting from one person, and to keep such

insurance in force for the term of the Agreement and to deliver proof of insurance if requested by either party after submitting the original Certificate of Insurance. All Certificates of Insurance must be approved by all legal counsel for the parties involved in this matter.

Section 9 - Governing Law

The Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

Section 10 - Independent Counsel

The parties hereby acknowledge that they have independent legal counsel of their own choosing in order to have this Agreement reviewed and approved and in order to receive independent and separate advice regarding every aspect of this Agreement.

Section 11 - Voluntary Execution and Authority

The parties each acknowledge and represent that this Agreement has been executed by them and each of them free from persuasion, fraud, undue duress or economical physical duress of any kind exerted by the other or other persons. The Wall Township EMS and MedStar acknowledge that this Agreement has been approved by Resolution and shall provide each other with a true copy of the same.

Section 12 -Partial Invalidity

Any provision of this shared services agreement which is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be prohibited or unenforceable shall be ineffective to the extent of such prohibition or unenforceability, without invalidating or rendering unenforceable the remaining provisions of this Shared Services Agreement.

Section 13 – Agency Relationship

It is hereby acknowledged that the parties and all of their personnel used to assist any party to this Agreement, are performing the services under this Agreement as general agents of the municipality where they are performing said services, and shall all of the powers of performance reasonably necessary and convenient to carry out the duties, obligations and responsibilities under the Agreement and allowable by law.

Section 14 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement sets forth all the covenants, agreements and understandings between the parties concerning the contract premises, the parties respectfully acknowledge that there are no covenants, promises, agreements or representation, inducements, conditions either oral or written between the parties other than those set forth in the Agreement. No alterations, amendments, changes or additions to this Agreement shall be binding upon either party unless reduced in writing and signed by each party.

Section 15 – Amendments

No provision of this Shared Services Agreement may be amended, waived or otherwise modified without the prior written consent of all of the parties hereto.

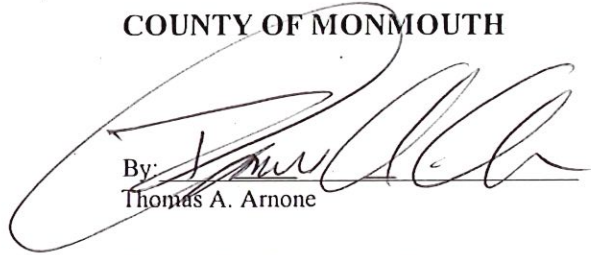

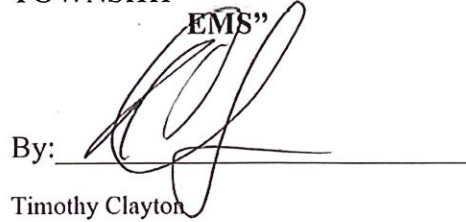

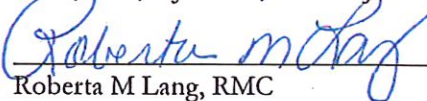

WHEREAS, the Township of Wall passed Resolution 2025-_____ at its June 11, 2025 meeting which authorized the Township of Wall to enter into this Shared Services Agreement with the COUNTY OF MONMOUTH for the provision of Emergency Medical Services pursuant to N.J.S.A 40A:65-1 *et. seq.*, the Uniform Shared Services; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS AGREED BY AND AMONG THE GOVERNING BODIES WHO HAVE DULY EXCUTED THIS AGREEMENT AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1 – Definitions:

As used herein:

- A. “Emergency Medical Services,” means a service engaged in providing initial emergency medical assistance on a Basic Life Support level.
- B. “Mutual Aid,” means the preplanned and organized response of emergency medical services, to a request for assistance in an emergency when local resources have been expended.
- C. “Mutual Aid Plan,” means a written Agreement between two or more jurisdiction which list responding agencies, personnel, and equipment.
- D. “Emergency Response Area,” means geographical boundaries used to define emergency medical services response capability by one or more EMS agencies. This can be EMS districts, township boundaries or any other area defined by local statute or contract Agreements.

Section 2 – Mutual Aid Agreement

- A. Wall Township EMS and MedStar mutually agree to provide mutual aid EMS services to each other which may include but not limited to the following reasons:
 - a. Pending Emergency Medical Calls

- b. Large Scale Incident (MCI) in which additional resources may be needed.
 - c. Stand-by for an event that may require additional units to cover as long as advances notice is given.
- B. The members of Wall Township EMS and MedStar may at times conduct coordinated and joint training sessions together to ensure inter agencies relationship and understanding.
- C. The EMS Managers of these programs will maintain contact to assure that the spirit of this Agreement is maintained to the mutual benefit of both entities.

Section 3 – Equipment

The final decision on the amount and type of equipment to be sent shall be based on availability of EMS units to still provide day to day care for its own Township and/or County services. Neither party to this agreement shall make any claim whatsoever against the other for refusal to send the requested personnel or equipment where such refusal is based on the lack of availability of services and/or equipment.

Section 4 – Terms of Agreement

This Agreement shall be in full force and effect upon execution by each party hereto. This Agreement shall remain in effect for an unlimited timeframe and reviewed on an annual basis. Cancellation by any party must be given with sixty-day written notice.

Section 5 – No Reimbursement for Cost

Neither party shall seek reimbursement from each other for services that are provided. Each shall pay its own cost (i.e. salaries, repairs, material, compensation, etc.) for responding for requests for mutual aid.

Section 6 – Fees for Ambulance

Agencies providing ambulance transport or other services normally billed for shall be entitled to their normal fees for services and are responsible for their own billing, insurance filing and collection activity.

Section 7 – Indemnification

Each responding party hereby waives all claims against each party for compensation for any and all property loss or damage and/or personal injury or death occurring as a consequence of the performance of this Agreement.

MedStar shall save and hold the Wall Township EMS, its officers, employees, elected officials and/or agents harmless from and against all liability, damage, loss, claim, demands and actions of any nature whatsoever, which arises out of, or are connected with or are claimed to arise out of or connected with the services provided by the Wall Township EMS. MedStar shall indemnify,

defend and hold the Wall Township EMS, its officers, employees, attorneys, agents or representatives, volunteers, successors and assigns, harmless from and against any claims, causes of action, costs, expenses, damages or liability that are asserted against the Wall Township EMS in connection the services provided under this Agreement. Without limitation of the foregoing, MedStar shall further indemnify and hold harmless the Wall Township EMS from and against any and all losses, costs or damages (including reasonable attorney's fees) with respect to any breach of any warranty or representation herein or its breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement, and all Third Party Claims of liability arising from or pertaining to the services undertaken by the Wall Township EMS for the residents of MedStar by the Wall Township EMS, its employees, volunteers, agents, representatives or contracted professionals.

LIKEWISE:

The Wall Township EMS shall save and hold the MedStar harmless from and against all liability, damage, loss, claim, demands and actions of any nature whatsoever, which arises out of, or are connected with or are claimed to arise out of or connected with the services provided by MedStar. The Wall Township EMS shall indemnify, defend and hold MedStar, its officers, employees, attorneys, agents or representatives, volunteers, successors and assigns, harmless from and against any claims, causes of action, costs, expenses, damages or liability that are asserted against MedStar in connection the services provided under this Agreement. Without limitation of the foregoing, the Wall Township EMS shall further indemnify and hold harmless MedStar from and against any and all losses, costs or damages (including reasonable attorney's fees) with respect to any breach of any warranty or representation herein or its breach of any of the provisions of this Agreement, and all Third Party Claims of liability arising from or pertaining to the services undertaken by MedStar for residents of the Wall Township EMS by MedStar, its employees, volunteers, agents, representatives or contracted professionals.

Section 8 – Insurance

Each party shall procure and maintain such insurances as is required by applicable federal and state laws and as may be appropriated and reasonable to cover its staff, equipment, vehicles, and property, including but not limited to liability insurance, workers' compensation, unemployment insurance, automobile liability, and property damage.

The parties hereby agree that the Wall Township EMS and MedStar shall maintain property insurance on all facilities and vehicles that may be affected by the services of the Agreement, with each party providing a Certificate of Insurance to the other naming each party as additional insured. Each party shall provide proof of insurance and maintain their own liability insurance and personal property insurance for any loss or damages arising from services provided and shall provide each other with a Certificate of Insurance, naming both as additional insured. All parties shall maintain a sum of no less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) for property loss and One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for liability for injuries resulting from one person, and to keep such

insurance in force for the term of the Agreement and to deliver proof of insurance if requested by either party after submitting the original Certificate of Insurance. All Certificates of Insurance must be approved by all legal counsel for the parties involved in this matter.

Section 9 - Governing Law

The Agreement shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.

Section 10 - Independent Counsel

The parties hereby acknowledge that they have independent legal counsel of their own choosing in order to have this Agreement reviewed and approved and in order to receive independent and separate advice regarding every aspect of this Agreement.

Section 11 - Voluntary Execution and Authority

The parties each acknowledge and represent that this Agreement has been executed by them and each of them free from persuasion, fraud, undue duress or economical physical duress of any kind exerted by the other or other persons. The Wall Township EMS and MedStar acknowledge that this Agreement has been approved by Resolution and shall provide each other with a true copy of the same.

Section 12 -Partial Invalidity

Any provision of this shared services agreement which is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be prohibited or unenforceable shall be ineffective to the extent of such prohibition or unenforceability, without invalidating or rendering unenforceable the remaining provisions of this Shared Services Agreement.

Section 13 – Agency Relationship

It is hereby acknowledged that the parties and all of their personnel used to assist any party to this Agreement, are performing the services under this Agreement as general agents of the municipality where they are performing said services, and shall all of the powers of performance reasonably necessary and convenient to carry out the duties, obligations and responsibilities under the Agreement and allowable by law.

Section 14 – Entire Agreement

This Agreement sets forth all the covenants, agreements and understandings between the parties concerning the contract premises, the parties respectfully acknowledge that there are no covenants, promises, agreements or representation, inducements, conditions either oral or written between the parties other than those set forth in the Agreement. No alterations, amendments, changes or additions to this Agreement shall be binding upon either party unless reduced in writing and signed by each party.

Section 15 – Amendments

No provision of this Shared Services Agreement may be amended, waived or otherwise modified without the prior written consent of all of the parties hereto.

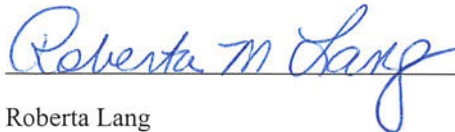

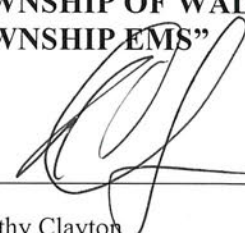
