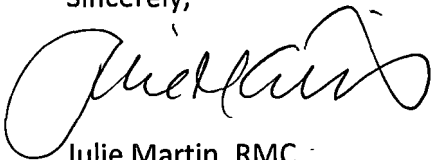

Your request will also require an additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to fulfill due to Borough Office Staff working a modified schedule because of the COVID 19 Pandemic and the anticipated volume of the request. OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advise by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied".

You request requires an extension of fifteen (15) business days from your acceptance of the estimated charge.

If you reject the estimated charge and you wish to challenge the special service charge, or if your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, at your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
