INVESTIGATIVE REPORT

JV INFO, NOT FOR RELEASE

The offense occurred on Saturday, May 28, 2022 at approximately 1630 hours. I, Officer Di Lauri, along with Lieutenant Foley, responded to the Wegmans security office for a shoplifting that had just occurred. When we arrived the security staff advised us that a [redacted] had attempted to steal \$127.31 in miscellaneous items from the store. She was stopped at the self check out aisle before she could leave. The staff also reported that [redacted] Julie Allen, was a frequent shoplifter that had been recently arrested and barred from the store.

I spoke with [redacted] who was seated inside the security office. I asked how she got to the store and she said her mother brought her. She reported that her mother drives a silver Honda CRV and was parked next to City MD. Since her mom was previously advised not to return to Wegmans property I confirmed with security staff that she was properly notified. Wegmans was able to produce a document with her signature that states she is barred from the property. Lieutenant Foley stayed with [redacted] while I searched the parking lot for Defendant Allen.

I located her vehicle parked next to City MD. I made contact with the Defendant and asked her where she dropped her daughter off at. She stated that she drove on to Wegmans property and dropped her off at the front entrance. She continued to say that she knows that she is not allowed on the property but it was raining out. Since it was raining she didn't want her daughter to get wet. I asked her to step out of the vehicle and placed her under arrest, double locking the cuffs for her safety. She was placed in the rear of MV368 and transported to MPD Headquarters for processing. I advised Lieutenant Foley of the arrest and to have her transport [redacted] to headquarters as well. Wegmans decided not to press charges against [redacted].

Upon arrival at MPD headquarters the Defendant was placed in cell 2. Lieutenant Foley conducted a search of the Defendant that was negative for contraband. [redacted] was seated in the hallway next to the processing area and monitored by an officer. The Defendant was charged on a summons S2022000061 for Defiant Trespassing 2C:18-3B(1) and given an initial court appearance date of [redacted] PM at Pascack Joint Municipal Court. The Defendant and her daughter were given a courtesy ride back to their vehicle. The Defendant was reminded again to not enter Wegmans property. Handle with care was completed and a e-mail was sent to [redacted] school.
