Dear Ms. Tietjen:

I am writing on behalf of my client, the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office (the "MCPO"), to respond to your April 21, 2025 request for the production of records through the Open Public Records Act (the "OPRA") and the common law right of access. This request was forwarded to my office as Special County Counsel for OPRA matters. This response is being provided to you within the period of time required by law.

The request you made is provided below in its entirety. You sought the following:

Records requested:

- any complaints against Ross Licitra between 1/1/18 and present
- any complaints against Ross Licitra for sexual harassment between 1/1/23 and present
- any communication from or any complaints filed by Shaun Golden in relation to Ross Licitra between 1/1/19 and 1/1/23

In response to your request, the MCPO searched its records and found no records responsive to your request. Your request for complaints led the MCPO to review its records for warrants or summonses to court for the party named in your request, as warrants and summonses are typically the documents that compose criminal complaints. From that search, the MCPO did not find any record of a complaint against the party named in your request for the identified time period. Further, the MCPO was unable to find any correspondence responsive to your request for communications for the identified time period. The MCPO's search for records has been concluded and this OPRA request is considered closed.
