Re: Open Public Records Act/Common Law Request

Dear Mr. Hampel:

The Saddle River School District (“District”) records custodian received your Open Public Records Act (“OPRA”) and common law request (“Request”) on December 18, 2023. On January 4, 2024, the District obtained an extension of time to respond to your Request until February 1, 2024. As such, the District is timely responding to your Request in accordance with New Jersey law.

Your Request seeks the following records:

All complaints filed against Board Member Evelyn Nissirios between January 1, 2023, and March 31, 2023, as received by the then Saddle River Board President, Mr. John Peros using the email address of johnperos@wandellschool.org

This includes, but is not limited to, written complaints and emails documenting allegations of wrongdoing against Ms. Nissirios.

Mr. Peros' response to each complaint: This includes any written communication from Mr. Peros acknowledging receipt of the complaint, outlining any investigation or internal procedures taken, and/or providing a decision or resolution regarding the complaint.

Ms. Evelyn Nissirios' recent reappointment to a board seat by the Saddle River Board, amid significant public scrutiny and opposition, including concerns raised by a newly elected Councilperson of Saddle River regarding the selection process, necessitates prompt attention to this request. It's essential that any related documents be provided as swiftly as possible, given the urgency of the situation.

Should there be a need for an extension, I expect a comprehensive explanation detailing the reasons for the delay, along with a projected timeline for the provision of the requested information.



Common Law Reason: Access to these records is crucial for understanding the nature of the complaints against Ms. Nissirios and the Board's response. This information is vital for public oversight and maintaining trust in our local government.

The District conducted a good-faith search and identified ten pages of e-mails (which also contain multiple attachments) as potentially responsive to your Request. The table below identifies the records that are being denied in whole or in part, as well as the legal basis for each denial, as required by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-6.

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To the extent that you have submitted your Request under the common law right of access, your Request is also denied. The District's interests in safeguarding both the citizen's privacy interest and Ms. Nissirios's interest in precluding potentially defamatory allegations from being publicly disseminated clearly exceeds your purported interest in accessing the materials in order to "understand the nature of the complaints against Ms. Nissirios and the Board's response," especially in light of the sensitive nature of the underlying communications.

Your Request is now deemed answered and closed. Thank you for your attention to this matter.
