Resolution # 2020-016
Evaluation and redistribution of annual LOSAP qualification points.

WHEREAS, The Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Borough of Buena, County of Atlantic, have reviewed and evaluated the categories, distribution, and assignment of LOSAP annual qualification points.

WHEREAS, The Commissioners upon review of LOSAP annual point categories have determined that the points categories for Incidents, Drills, Training and Special Assignments will be adjusted.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have agreed to adjust the category points as follows:

- (1) **Incidents** = One-and-one half (1.5) points shall be awarded for each fire call member response between the hours of 0700hrs – 2259hrs; **and** Two-and-one half (2.5) points shall be awarded for each fire call member response between the hours of 2300hrs – 0659hrs. *No max*
- (2) **Drills** = Two points shall be awarded for each drill attended. *No max*
- (3) **Training** = One point for the first hour of training; and .25 points for each additional half-hour attended (i.e. 3-hours of training = 2 points) *30-point max*
- (4) **Meetings** = One point for each meeting attended *10-point max*
- (5) **Special Assignments** = One point for the first hour of the special assignment; and .25 points for each additional half-hour attended (i.e. 3-hour special assignment = 2 points) *10-point max*

SPECIAL CONSIDERATION FOR COMPLETION OF FIREFIGHTER II

Anyone completing Firefighter II after January 1, 2021 would be eligible to receive eighty (80) points upon successful completion of the course and receipt of State Certification.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Commissioners of Fire District No. 2 in the Borough of Buena, County of Atlantic, that the revised LOSAP categories and associated distribution of annual LOSAP qualification points shall become effective January 1, 2021.
