RESOLUTION 21-301

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF BODY WORN CAMERA'S, HARDWARE FOR VEHICLES AND CAD INTEGRATION FOR OLD BRIDGE TOWNSHIP POLICE DEPARTMENT THROUGH THE NEW JERSEY COOPERATIVE PURCHASING ALLIANCE THROUGH THE LEAD AGENCY BERGEN COUNTY #CK04-BERGEN SHI, INTERNATIONAL CORPORATION, VENDOR CODE 23242 AND BID #19-34

WHEREAS, the Township of Old Bridge as a contracting unit may, without advertising for bids, purchase any materials, supplies, equipment or services under any contract or contracts for such materials, supplies, equipment or services from vendors entered into on behalf of the New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Alliance by County of Bergen #CK04-Bergen pursuant to the provision of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-11 and N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Old Bridge has an authorized agreement with the New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing / County of Bergen #CK-04-Bergen through Resolution #21-190; and

WHEREAS, Acting Chief Mandola, has requested the authority to purchase body worn cameras for 70 sworn officers, required equipment for 35 vehicles and CAD Integration software for the Township of Old Bridge Police Department; and

WHEREAS, Sgt. Herbert K .Doctors, received a pricing proposal from SHI International Corporation Quotation # 20385290 for all of the necessary equipment in the amount of \$681,915.05 from SHI New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Alliance #CK-04-Bergen, sub-contractor 19-34; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council of the Township of Old Bridge wishes to authorize the Purchasing Department to purchase those certain items and services from an approved New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Alliance # CK04-Bergen Vendor SHI subcontract #19-34 for body worn cameras, vehicle hardware and CAD integration to be financed through the Body Worn Camera Grant with initial payment of \$305,700.00 and then \$94,035.75 annually for the next four (4) years; and

WHEREAS, the initial payment of \$305,700.00, is funded by the body camera grant account and the remaining yearly payments in 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 in the amount of \$94,035.75 are contingent upon the funds being available in the funding year the payment is due; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Old Bridge, County of Middlesex and State of New Jersey as follows; and

1. A contract with SHI having an address at 300 Davidson Avenue, Somerset, NJ 08873 is hereby approved for the purchase of body worn camera's, vehicle hardware, and CAD integration for the Township's Police Department in an amount not to exceed \$681,915.05 (Body Camera Grant) pursuant to the April 26, 2021, quotation submitted by SHI through the New Jersey Cooperative Purchasing Alliance # CK04-Bergen Vendor SHI subcontract #19-34.
2. The award of the contract is contingent upon the issuance of a Certification of Availability of Funds in the years 2022, 2023, 2024, 2025 certifying the existence of a sufficient appropriation to fund the said contract payments in years 2022, 2023, 2024 and 2025.
3. The Mayor and Township Clerk or other appropriate Township official are hereby authorized to sign the contract documents necessary to effectuate the award of this contract. The Township Attorney shall review any and all contractual documents prepared in furtherance of this award.

This Resolution is conditioned upon the following:

- A. To the extent required, execution of a contract approved by the Director of Law which is signed by the Mayor and Township Clerk or another appropriate Township official.
- B. Issuance of a certificate of Availability of Funds as aforesaid; Certificate Number 2861.

No contract shall be considered awarded unless, and until, the above requirements are executed.
