Thank you for contacting the Department of Community Affairs (DCA), Office of Ethics on June 11, 2019 with your request, which was submitted pursuant to the Open Public Records Act (OPRA) for the following:

“I'm requesting copies of OPRA requests received by your office from August 1, 2017 to November 20, 2017. I'm also requesting copies of ethics complaints filed against DCA employees working in the various DCA departments or divisions, including the Office of Ethics.”

This response to your request is being provided to you on today's date, June 19, 2019, which is on the sixth (6th) business day that the custodian was in receipt of said request.

A response will be provided for each section of your request for "copies of OPRA requests received by your office from August 1, 2017 to November 20, 2017" and “copies of ethics complaints filed against DCA employees working in the various DCA departments or divisions, including the Office of Ethics.”

1) Request for copies of OPRA requests received by your office from August 1, 2017 to November 20, 2017.

DCA conducted a search for records responsive to your request and found one record, which is attached.

2) Request for copies of ethics complaints filed against DCA employees working in the various DCA departments or divisions, including the Office of Ethics from August 1, 2017 to November 20, 2017.

DCA conducted a search for records and did not find any records responsive to your request.

I trust this provides you with the means of obtaining the records you are seeking. OPRA request C146733 is hereby deemed to be closed.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Department of Community Affairs, Office of Ethics to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
