On Tuesday, May 15, 2018 at approximately 2100 hours I responded to the lobby of 255 Oak Avenue in reference to a civil matter.

Upon arrival I met with the victim, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] advised me she was assaulted on May 14, 2018 at approximately 0330 hours by the suspect, Justin Lamb. [REDACTED] advised me that Mr. Lamb serves as a Police Sergeant at the Lavallette Police Department. [REDACTED] said the assault took place at Mr. Lamb's residence located at [REDACTED] Buermann Avenue in Toms River. [REDACTED] said she has been living at the residence full time since January 2018. [REDACTED] also stated she has been involved in a dating relationship with Mr. Lamb for approximately six months. [REDACTED] said she has furniture at the residence but does not receive the majority of her mail at the residence in question. [REDACTED] said she occasionally received packages from Amazon at the address and she paid rent in the amount of \$250 to Mr. Lamb to reside at the address.

and Mr. Lamb became angry. [REDACTED] said Mr. Lamb charged her from the bed and grabbed her by both arms. She said Mr. Lamb threw her to the ground and began to kick her out of the way of the door. [REDACTED] said when Mr. Lamb realized he injured her, he ran out of the residence and left the location. [REDACTED] said she grabbed some of her belongings and immediately left the location. [REDACTED] had visible signs of injury to her arms and knees which coincided with the reported incident of abuse. [REDACTED]

██████████ A NJ Victim Notification Form was completed and signed by the victim. I then advised ██████████ of her right to speak to a member of the Domestic Violence Response Team, which she declined. A Toms River Township DVRT Form was completed and signed by the victim. Lastly, a NJ Supplementary Domestic Violence Offense Report was completed. The victim was served at this time with her copy of the Temporary Restraining Order.

The suspect, Justin Lamb then responded to District 1 to be processed on the charge of Simple Assault. Mr. Lamb's duty weapon was confiscated by Lavallette Chief of Police Colin Grant. Mr. Lamb voluntarily turned over two personal firearms, ██████████ and one ██████████. His NJ Firearms ID Card could not be located at this time. Chief Grant informed Lt. Miller that he will turn it in once it is located. The two personal firearms were submitted into evidence and stored in Evidence Locker 5. Mr. Lamb was placed on a Summons and served with the complaint as well as the Temporary Restraining Order. Mr. Lamb was then released from custody. Nothing further at this time.
