Arrived on site approx 1315. Met with complainant. [REDACTED] brought me to the location of the stream, which was on Morningdale Rd. Grass Hollow Branch flows under the road near the Toms River MUA Pump Station. In the area of the road, it looks like the stream bed has been widened to look like a small retention basin. The water in this area is very heavily covered with algae, both floating and submerged. SEE ATTACHED PHOTOS. Upstream of the affected area is wooded before leading into the Fairways development. I investigated possible downstream impacts in the Stream behind Saratoga at Toms River Development. The stream leads into a large retention pond behind the clubhouse. No excessive algae was observed in this area.

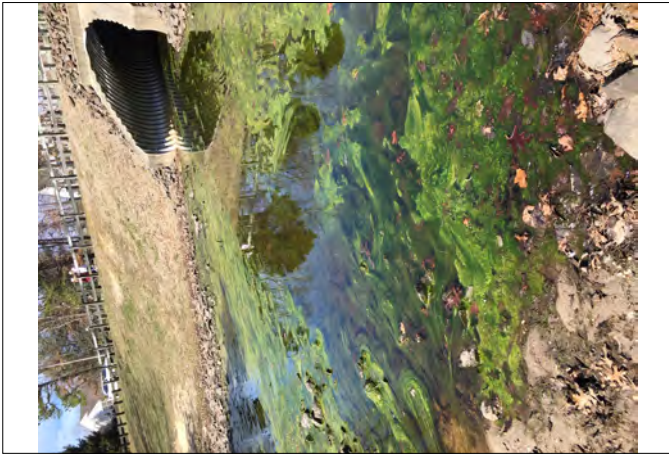

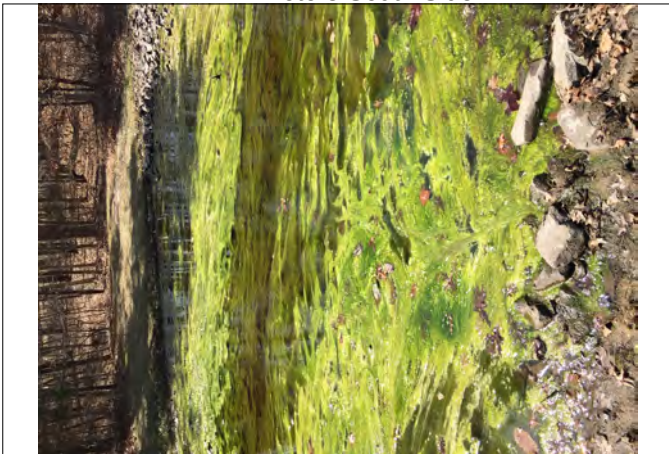
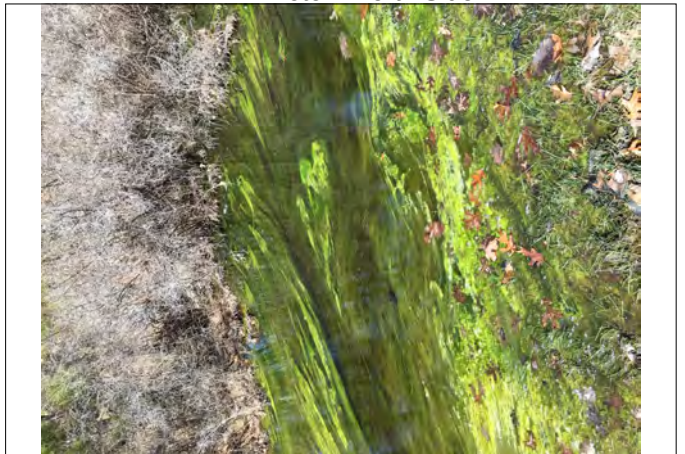

Spoke with Dan Lockward, NJDEP Water C & E. I advised him of my findings and that I could not identify a cause of the algae bloom. He indicated that he would contact the inspector for Fairways at Lake Ridge to advise of possible runoff from that development.
