The Township of Medford received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on July 20, 2022. The official Records Custodian received your OPRA request on July 20, 2022. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is August 2, 2022. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 1st business day after the custodian's receipt of your request.

The following records are being requested:

Copy of all documents from all government bodies regarding redevelopment of 17-19 N. Main Street, including but not limited to: All postings in the newspapers, all letters and notices sent to neighboring properties, all notifications made to current and prior owners in the area; all documents and communications with the Commissioner of Community Affairs, notice of determination sent to neighboring properties, the planning map showing the boundaries of the proposed redevelopment area and the location of the various parcels of property included therein.

These records are being transmitted to you via email, as per your request. There is no cost for this request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Medford to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
