135 Crash Description

- Vehicle 1 was traveling south on Chambers Bridge Road approaching the intersection with the entrance/exit to Kohl's Plaza.
- Vehicle 1 for unknown reasons veered off to the right and impacted the curbed island to the entrance/exit of Kohl's Plaza.
- Vehicle 1 continued southbound on Chambers Bridge Road impacting a fire hydrant and utility pole (#JC 412 BK) before coming to final rest in the outside lane of Chambers Bridge Road southbound.
- As a result of the impact with the utility pole, power lines were pulled down causing the traffic signal and underground wiring at the intersection to catch fire.
- An odor of alcoholic beverage was detected on the breath of the driver of Vehicle 1 by officers at the scene as well as the driver stating that he had been drinking.
- The driver of Vehicle 1 was transported to Ocean Medical Center-Brick for treatment of possible head injuries.
- Ptl. Pawlowicz 168 responded to Ocean Medical Center-Brick with the first aid and obtained blood samples from the driver of Vehicle 1.
- The driver of Vehicle 1 could not recall the events surrounding the crash.
- The driver of Vehicle 1 was issued summonses for Careless Driving and Driving Under the Influence of Alcohol on Summons numbers T111734-T111735

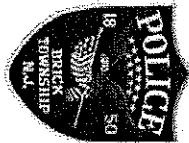

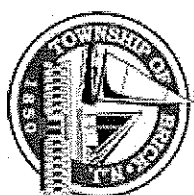

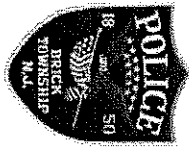

On Sunday, February 5, 2012 at approximately 2015 hours, I responded to Chambers Bridge Road in the area of the entrance to Kohl's Plaza in reference to a motor vehicle crash. The crash involved one vehicle that impacted a utility pole. The driver of the vehicle had been transported to Ocean Medical Center-Brick prior to my arrival to be treated for possibly head injuries. Upon my arrival I was briefed by Sgt. Naiduk 195 and Ptl. Rossi 241, the first responding officer on the scene.

Ptl. Rossi advised me that upon arriving on scene, the driver, Neil Napolitano was laying in the northbound side of Chambers Bridge Road being tended to by a fireman from Station 22. That fireman was later identified as Andrew Quinlan, an EMT as well. Quinlan had left the scene prior to my arrival. Ptl. Rossi informed me that originally it appeared that Napolitano was the only subject in his vehicle at the time of the crash, however while questioning him others may have been in the vehicle with him. Napolitano had stated that he was alone in the vehicle and then a short time later inquired how the others in the vehicle were. When asked who those subjects were, Napolitano stated "no one, never mind. I don't want to answer anymore questions." While checking Napolitano's vehicle for documents pertaining to the vehicle, Rossi observed two cell phones on the passenger's side floor of the vehicle. An indication that there was more than one subject in the vehicle. Rossi also heard bystanders at the scene conversing about how they observed subjects running away from the vehicle into Kohl's Plaza. Rossi was unable to obtain those bystander's information. See Ptl. Rossi's report.

Sgt. Naiduk advised me that Ptl. Pawlowicz 168 responded to Ocean Medical Center-Brick in the ambulance with Napolitano to obtain samples of his blood. At the scene Napolitano stated that he had several beers prior to the crash and that an odor of alcoholic beverage was detected on his breath. See Ptl. Pawlowicz's report.

Det. Waldhelm arrived to photograph and process the scene. All road evidence was marked and recorded. The Ocean County Prosecutor's Office was notified and would not be responding to the scene.

Following my on scene investigation, I responded to Ocean Medical Center-Brick, to speak with Ptl. Pawlowicz and Napolitano. Concerned for the safety and well being of the other occupants who may have been with Napolitano at the time of the crash, I asked Napolitano who those subjects were. Napolitano repeatedly stated no one. After advising Napolitano that there were other cell phones in the vehicle, bystanders observed subjects running from the vehicle and the seriousness of the consequences if any of those subject are injured, Napolitano still stated he was alone in the vehicle. I showed him both cell phones and asked him who's they were. He stated one was his and the other one was his cousins. His cousin was later identified as James Moore, [REDACTED]. Napolitano stated that Moore was in the vehicle with him at the time of the crash and then minutes later recanted it saying no one was in the vehicle with him. Napolitano stated that he could not recall the events surrounding the crash and that the only thing he remembers was driving down Chambers Bridge Road. It was evident that Napolitano was uncooperative. Just prior to leaving the area Napolitano was being treated, he stated that Moore was in the vehicle with him and advised him it was okay to leave. Moore was not injured and didn't want him to have to be involved in the incident. He stated the kid was young and "I had a few beers".

As I was speaking with Napolitano's wife and his father in the waiting area, explaining to them that charges against Napolitano are pending the blood results and investigation, I was approached by Ptl. Pawlowicz. Pawlowicz advised me that after I left the room, Napolitano stated to him that there was another subject in the vehicle at the time of the crash. The subject was Patrick Mangold, a friend of his. The reason the two fled after the crash was because Mangold had outstanding warrants. Napolitano was released from the hospital was left in the care of his wife Tatyana Napolitano.

Prior to securing from Ocean Medical Center, Napolitano's cousin James Moore responded to there after being contacted by Napolitano's father. Moore stated that they were at the Mantoloking Pub watching the Super Bowl and then left there to go to a friends house during half time to visit. They were on their way back to the Mantoloking Pub and traveling southbound on Chambers Bridge Road. Moore stated that he really doesn't remember how the crash took place other than the vehicle just veered off to the right. After the crash Mangold and he took off. They notified a family member of Napolitano's about the crash and then went back to the Mantoloking Pub.

On Monday, February 6, 2012, I spoke with Andrew Quinlan. Quinlan stated that he was in the area at the time of the crash and observed an explosion in that area. He did not actually witness the crash however. As he pulled up he observed Napolitano's Jeep on the south side of Chambers Bridge Road with wires down around it. An unidentified subject was helping Napolitano out of the vehicle. With that he observed two subjects run from Napolitano's vehicle. They escorted Napolitano over to the north side of the roadway. Napolitano was dazed and confused but was not unconscious. Napolitano was combative as they attempted to have him lay down. Napolitano wanted to remain standing. Approximately two minutes from the time he first got there, police and EMS units arrived on location.

On Monday, February 6, 2012, Napolitano responded to the Traffic Safety Unit. After providing proof of insurance for his vehicle the vehicle was released to him.

As of Friday, March 2, 2012 the blood test results on Napolitano from the Ocean County Sheriffs Department had not been made available. Napolitano was charged with careless driving on summons number T 111734. The violation was mailed to Napolitano certified mail. Napolitano signed for the summons on March 6, 2012.

On Monday, March 19, 2012, I contacted the Ocean County Sheriffs Department's Criminal Investigation Unit in reference to Napolitano's blood samples. I was advised that the tests were complete and Napolitano's blood was a .22% B.A.C.

On, Tuesday, March 20, 2012, Napolitano was charged with Driving Under the Influence of alcohol on summon number T111735. Due to Napolitano being a non resident, the violation was mailed to his residence via certified mail.

OfficerID: Jpawlowicz, Narrative

On 02/05/2012 at 1950 hrs Sgt. Naiduk #195, Ptl. J Rossi #240, Ptl. J Sutton #239 and I were dispatched to Chambers Bridge Rd by Shop Rite for a reported MVA.

Upon arrival I observed a blue 2003 Jeep Wrangler (NJ registration WAY-61D) with extensive front end damage due to crashing into an Electric Pole.

The driver of the vehicle later identified as Neil Napolitano was lying on the ground. He was removed from the vehicle prior to our arrival. Napolitano was disoriented and had a strong odor of alcoholic beverage on his breath. Napolitano stated that he had several beers, but not a lot. He also stated that he was driving the jeep when it crashed.

Due to Napolitano's disoriented state and the fact that Medics believed Napolitano may have suffered a head injury no psycho physical test were performed on the scene.

Napolitano was transported to Brick Hospital via First Aid and Medics. I stayed with Napolitano during transport. Based on the events of the crash in which Napolitano was the driver and the odor of alcoholic beverage on his breath, blood was drawn based on probable cause. Once at the hospital blood was drawn from Napolitano and placed into property according to department policy.

Plt. J Lampiasi #156 of the traffic safety unit responded to the hospital and I briefed him of my dealings with Napolitano. Ptl. Lampiasi spoke with Napolitano see his report for further details.
