Team DEVCO volunteered at Elijah's Promise to serve dinner to the New Brunswick community.



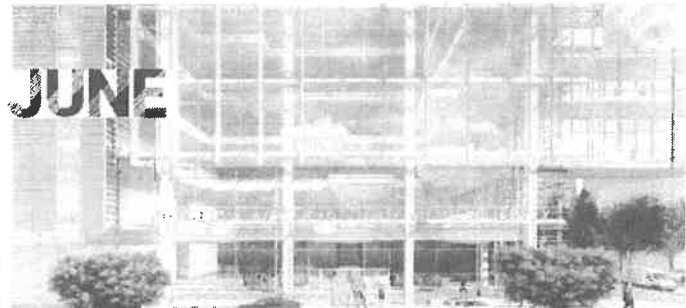
APRIL
