NARRATIVE

On Saturday April 25, 2015 at approximately 1234 hrs. I was dispatched to the Calvary Cemetery on Washington Road for a dumping complaint. Upon arrival, I spoke to Mr. Brian Swider who was on the property with his personal vehicle. Mr. Swider stated that his employee had just left the property with a load of soil. This officer was able to confirm this as the pile of soil had a fresh scoop removed from a loader as the exposed soil from the bucket was moist unlike the rest of the pile which was dry from the sun. Mr.

Swider stated that he has permission to be on the property through his friend Mr. Gregory Camerato who is a local landscaper. Mr. Swider volunteered to this officer that he was also on the property last night around 1830 hrs. moving dirt around with Mr. Cameratos machines as well. Mr. Swider stated that he was not dumping, just assisting in moving dirt off of the property for Father Thomas F. Ryan. After speaking with Mr. Swider he was allowed to leave the scene and was told if I need anymore information I would see him at his shop on Washington Road.

Moments after Mr. Swider leaving the property Father Ryan arrived. Father Ryan stated that he received a third party call informing him that Mr. Swider was using the machines as late as 2000 and 2100 hrs last night in the rear right corner of the property where all of the piles of soil, wood chips, and black top millings are. I asked Father Ryan if he saw anything on the property that was not supposed to be there and he stated that all of the piles of soil, chips, and millings that are there have been there. Father Ryan stated that he gave Mr. Camerato permission to store what was there along with his machines however never gave permission to Mr. Swider to operate on the cemetery. I asked Father Ryan if his third party caller provided any additional information regarding the dumping aspect of the call and he replied yes, there may be things buried underground. This officer would like to note that prior to asking that question, I did find that an area approximately 50x50 directly adjacent to the two piles of blacktop millings appeared to be spread out and graded. There were numerous vehicle and machine tire tracks over the millings as if vehicles drove over it quite a bit.

Father Ryan expressed to this officer that he does not want to move forward with this investigation until he speaks with a few people. I advised Father Ryan that I would be completing the initial report with my findings as well as the conversations with all parties involved which would be on file if he wished to pursue the matter. Father Ryan stated that upon speaking with whoever he had to discuss the matter with he will be opening up the ground to investigate further this way the Sayreville Police Department can also proceed. No further police action.

subject with a heavy build. Driver #1 stated that after the accident, Driver #2 moved his car to the side of the road, but then left the scene towards Minnisink Avenue.

I then spoke to a witness who wished to remain anonymous and lives at 511 Washington Road. She stated that she heard the accident and then walked over to check on the involved parties. She gave a similar description of the vehicle as Driver #1 did, and stated that she was able to get the registration of Vehicle #2. She gave the registration as NJ XY915B, but that registration came back to a Toyota Corolla. She also gave a similar description of Driver #2 as Driver #1 did.

Vehicle #2 left a trail of fluid as it was leaving the scene, and Ptl. Calise then followed the trail. He located the vehicle (NJ reg. XS915B) in the driveway of 12 Harrison St., and I then made contact with Driver #2. Driver #2 stated that Driver #1 came to an abrupt stop, and Driver #2 then struck Driver #1. Driver #2 stated that he then panicked and left the scene. No injuries reported at this time. Driver #2 issued summonses for leaving the scene of an accident (summons #1219E14004682), failure to report an accident (summons #1219E14004683), and careless driving (summons #1219E14004684).

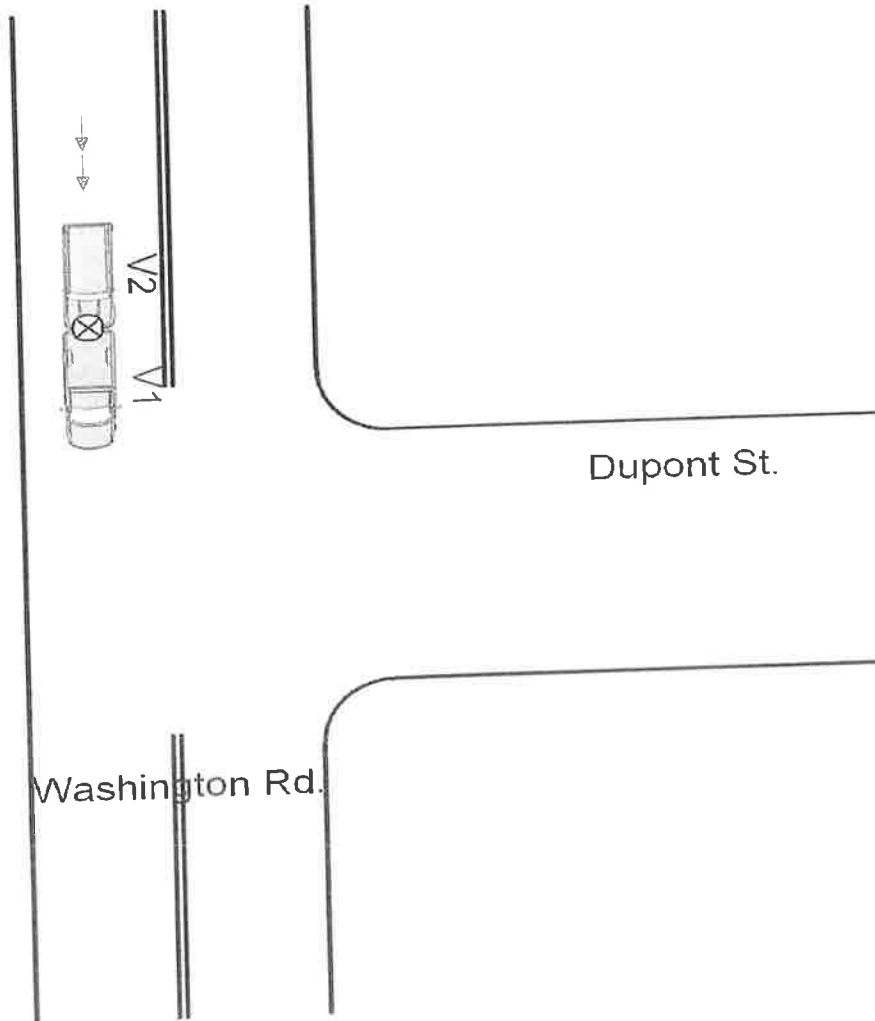
Motor Vehicle Crash Diagram

I was dispatched to _____ to take a report of harassment. Upon arrival, I spoke with Greg Camerato. Camerato stated that he is having an ongoing problem with his Ex-girlfriend's new boyfriend. Camerato explained that his Ex, Rosemarie Gawroriski, formally lived with him at _____. Although they are no longer dating, Camerato and Gawroriski have remained friends and talk or text each other on occasion. Gawroriski's new boyfriend, James Mullin, learned of the communications and is not happy with Camerato and Gawroriski remaining

in contact with each other. Camerato and Mullin have been in contact with each other in reference to the issues, not always favorably. Recently, Camerato has received numerous text messages that were from Gawroriski's cell phone, but because of the nature of the messages, Camerato feels they were authored by Mullin.

In the most recent incident, Camerato received at his residence, a letter from Blue Cross and Blue Shield that was addressed Gawroriski's daughter. Feeling that the letter was of an important nature and needed to be forwarded to Gawroriski, Camerato text a message to her. In the message, Camerato asked how he should get the letter to her. The two then text back and forth about the letter with several messages. Today, both Gawroriski and Mullin showed up at Camerato's residence and property. Things were not so amicable, and at some point in their discussion, Mullin stated to Camerato, "Your gonna loose, and gonna loose bad. Your a cunt and asshole, and your a coward 'cause you know you can't do nothin' about it. I know your business." Due to Mullin's employment and position, Camerato took those statements as threatening in nature.

Camerato then enquired as to the procedure for signing a complaint, or contacting internal affairs, in reference to the incident. I advised him of how to do both or either, and I also advised him of the procedure to apply for a temporary restraining order should he decide to do so. After further discussion, Camerato stated that he would let some time pass, and further discuss the situation with his attorney. No further action needed at this time.

Gregory stated approximately one month ago he loaned \$1000 to a friend, Albert Bolk. Around the same time, Rosemarie stated she loaned \$800 to Albert's wife, Carrie Bolk. At the time of the loans, both Gregory and Rosemarie were unaware that the other had also

lent the money.

Since the loan, Gregory had been receiving sexual advances from Carrie via text messages. He also received several picture messages from Carrie of her in a pornographic nature. Gregory told Carrie he was not interested in a married woman. Albert had confronted Gregory accusing him of making sexual advances on Carrie and threatened physical violence towards him via text message.

Gregory believes that this is a ploy from Albert and Carrie to default on repaying their loans. Gregory stated he also had received harassing text messages from other various family members of the Bolks. Gregory wanted the incident documented because he stated the Bolks were making false accusations that he was harassing them. Gregory and Rosemarie were advised on how to sign complaints for their respective issues. Nothing further at this time.

The headstone itself also is knocked loose from its base and is turned slightly sideways and is apparent that it has been that way for some time due to the way the grass is growing next to it. There are also old wooden spikes in the ground preventing the headstone from moving any further.
