WHEREAS, the Borough requested from the New Jersey Civil Service Commission a Certification of Eligibles for Appointment to fill vacancies in the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Civil Service Commission subsequently supplied the Borough with a Certification of Eligibles for Appointment Certification #OL170561, dated May 4, 2017, containing twenty-five (25) individuals eligible for appointment; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Police Department had reviewed the list of potential applicants from the Civil Service Eligibility List, No. OL170561; and

WHEREAS, after a thorough selection process Matthew Siemaszkiewicz, one of the eligibles named on the aforementioned list, was selected to fill the vacancy; and

WHEREAS, Matthew Siemaszkiewicz has passed the required background checks, has been given a "Conditional Offer of Employment" and passed the medical/psychological examinations; and

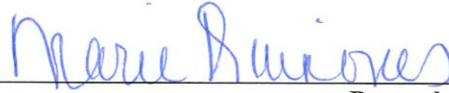
WHEREAS, Bergenfield Police Chief Cathy Madalone has recommended that Matthew Siemaszkiewicz be hired effective July 18, 2017 to fill the vacancies in the Bergenfield Police Department, provided that he successfully completes the Bergen County Law & Public Safety Institute's Pre-Entry Physical Fitness Test, as well as any educational requirement(s) that is required from the Bergen County Law & Public Safety Academy.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Bergenfield that the Borough of Bergenfield is hereby authorized to hire Matthew Siemaszkiewicz as a full-time police officer of the Bergenfield Police Department, who shall be paid a salary in conformance with the PBA Agreement for officers entering the training step of employment in the Department, and shall be given all benefits currently provided under the present union agreement between the Borough and its Police Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough Administrator be and he is hereby authorized and directed to forward a certified copy of this resolution to the Police Chief and Police Officer Matthew

Siemaszkiewicz immediately upon its passage and to place a copy of said resolution in Officer Siemaszkiewicz's personnel file.
