Dear Sir/Madam:

The Ocean County Health Department and Custodian of Records received your OPRA requests, dated, March 6, 2022, received on March 7, 2022. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is March 16, 2022. This answer is being furnished to you on the 3rd day of your request.

OPRA allows public agencies to impose special service charges whenever the nature, format, manner of collection or volume of a government record embodied in the form or printed matter to be inspected, examined or copied pursuant to this section is such that the record cannot be reproduced by ordinary documents copying equipment in ordinary business size or when fulfilling a request requires an extraordinary expenditure of time and effort. (See N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5c). Special service charges must be based upon the actual direct cost of providing the copy or copies.

OPRA mandates that the requestor shall have the opportunity to review and object to the charge prior to it being incurred. (See N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5c). As such, a detailed estimate is provided below:

Copies of the requested document total (1) pages in a variety of sizes.

- **Copies** of the document can be made available at a cost of \$.05 per letter size page or smaller and \$.07 per legal size page or larger totaling **\$0.05**.
- The documents can be **faxed** upon receiving a fax number at **no cost**.

We will not begin to process this request until we receive your written acceptance.

Please be advised, as per N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1 (Legislative Findings): 24) Privacy Interest - "a public agency has a responsibility and an obligation to safeguard from public access a citizen's personal information with which it has been entrusted when disclosure thereof would violate the citizen's reasonable expectation of privacy." The Complainant Names, phone numbers, and personally identifying information has been redacted from these files prior to disclosure.

Additionally, as per the Private Well Testing Act: water test results are not to be made available for public examination, inspection, or copying (N.J.A.C 7:9E-5.1). Water test lab results will be removed prior to disclosure.

If you reject the estimated charge and you wish to challenge the special service charge, you have a right to challenge the decision. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council. If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have the right to challenge the decision by the Ocean County Health Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with Government Records Council.
