Incident: False Public Alarm

On 03-08-2008 at approximately 0220 hours, I along with fire personnel were dispatched to 511 N. Arkansas Ave (Westside Bar), in reference to a fire alarm went off. Upon arrival, when I along with fire personnel obtaining information from the bar employee, I heard on the radio that Lieutenant Anderson was flagged down by the bar Manager, Michael Maltese, in reference a bar patron, set off the fire alarm at the premise, and then left. Lieutenant Anderson had the bar patron stop, about one block away from the bar, just right outside the rescue mission.

I was then dispatched to meet with Lieutenant Anderson, upon arrival; I met the bar manager, Michael Maltese, Lieutenant Anderson, and two females, one male. The two females were later identified as Jacquelin Divirgilio, and Lauren Cardew, the male was identified as John P Acampora. The bar manager, Mr. Maltese stated he saw Mr. Acampora pulled the fire alarm off, he also stated that he has the video camera, showing Mr. Acampora pulled off the alarm.

I asked Mr. Acampora that did he set off the fire alarm, Mr.

Acampora responded "yes, I did, but I didn't do it intentional". I

asked Mr. Acampora how he set the fire alarm off, he explained in an unclear story that when he grabbed the drinks, from his friends, he accidentally touched the alarm. Mr. Acampora appeared to be intoxicated; I smelled a strong odor of alcohol beverage, from his breath as he was speaking.

I advised Mr. Acampora that he is under arrest, for making false public alarm. Mr. Acampora was placed into custody, and I transported him to the Atlantic City Booking and Detention without incident. Mr. Maltese provided an incident statement.
