Narrative

Toms River Police Department Investigation Narrative

On 10/07/2020 at 13:34 hours, the undersigned along with Sgt. Scali, Ptl. Broderick and Ptl. Durkin were dispatched to the area of Route 37 and Rout 166 for a disorderly in progress. While responding dispatch notified units that the parties involved were to the rear of the Crystal Diner. Upon arrival I spoke with [REDACTED] who states that she was assaulted as a result of a road rage incident.

[REDACTED] states that she was driving east on Route 37 near the intersection with Route 166. She states that the vehicle(NJ Reg: [REDACTED] in front of her, described as white Nissan Altima, occupied by three white females was driving slow. Ms. [REDACTED] states that the females were giving her the middle finger and yelling at her. Ms. [REDACTED] states that she changed lanes to the right lane as it would put the Altima one vehicle behind her and in another lane so that the yelling would stop. She then states that the female in the front passenger seat, later identified as [REDACTED] exited her vehicle and walked up to Ms. [REDACTED] vehicle. Ms. [REDACTED] states that the female continued to yell and was being aggressive. Ms. [REDACTED] states she warned Ms. [REDACTED] to get away or she would pepper spray her at which time Ms. [REDACTED] calls her a nigger. Ms. [REDACTED] continued yelling at which time Ms. [REDACTED] Sprayed her and exited her vehicle. Ms. [REDACTED] states that Ms. [REDACTED] then pushed her to the ground. While on the ground Ms. [REDACTED] states the rear passenger of the Altima, later identified as [REDACTED] exited and removed the pepper spray from her hand. Ms. [REDACTED] states that she also lost a ring from her finger during the fight. Both females then separated and one of them notified an Ocean County Sheriff Officer who was in the jug handle to go Route 166 north.

In speaking with [REDACTED] she states that she was in her mothers vehicle with [REDACTED] Mother/Witness, driving and her sister, [REDACTED] in the rear passenger seat. They are driving east on Route 37 near Hospital Drive when a black female driving a tan Ford Edge(NJ Reg [REDACTED] is right on their back bumper yelling and making hand gestures. Ms. [REDACTED] figured it was because of her mother driving slower. Ms. [REDACTED] states that the aggressive driving continued until they stopped at the red traffic signal for Rout 37 and Route 166. Ms. [REDACTED] states that Ms. [REDACTED] changed in to the right lane as they stayed in the middle one car length to the rear. Ms. [REDACTED] states that it was at this time Ms. [REDACTED] exited her vehicle yelling and then kicked the front passenger side of her vehicle. At this time Ms. [REDACTED] exited the front passenger seat and confronted Ms. [REDACTED] Ms. [REDACTED] states that it was then that Ms. [REDACTED] sprayed her with pepper spray. [REDACTED] states that this is when she removed the pepper spray from Ms. [REDACTED] hand. [REDACTED] states that she never got out of her vehicle. There was no damage observed to the passenger side of Ms. [REDACTED] vehicle. [REDACTED] also refused medical attention.

While investigating the incident [REDACTED] arrived on scene. [REDACTED] is the father of [REDACTED] Mr. [REDACTED] was angry over the situation. Once I advised Ms. [REDACTED] of complaint procedures Mr. [REDACTED] stated "so you are not going to do anything about this". I advised him that since we did not witness the incident that we could not charge or arrest anybody. He then stated "I will handle this my way". Ms. [REDACTED] has an abrasion on her left elbow which she states is from being pushed to the ground. I asked her if she wanted an ambulance and she stated no.

I advised all parties of complaint procedures and provided them with report information cards.
