Dear Mike:

The County of Salem received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on January 23, 2024. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is February 1, 2024. This response to your request is being provided to you on the 1st business day after the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

"I am respectfully requesting a copy of most recent and/or current contract agreement including but not limited to any Memorandum(s) of Understanding (MOU) or Memorandum(s) of Agreement (MOA) between the Salem County Prosecutor/County of Salem and the Detectives/Investigators of the Salem County Prosecutor's Office."

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request:

1. Agreement between Salem County Prosecutor and Salem County Prosecutor's Office Detectives and Investigators Association, Effective January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2025
2. Agreement between Salem County Prosecutor and Salem County Prosecutor's Superior Officers' Association, Effective January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2025
3. Agreement between County of Salem and Assistant Prosecutors of Salem County, Effective January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2024.

These records are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the County of Salem to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
