The County of Salem received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on March 26, 2025. This is an immediate access OPRA request. This response to your request is being provided to you on the same business day as the custodian's receipt of said request.

Your OPRA request sought access to the following:

"I am respectfully requesting a copy of most recent and/or current contract agreement including but not limited to any Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) or Memorandums of Agreement between the County of Salem Board of Freeholders and the Salem County Sheriff's Officer Association."

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request:

Contract between County of Salem and Salem County Sheriff's Officers Association and contract between County of Salem and Salem County Sheriff's Superior Officers Association.

These records are being transmitted to you via e-mail, as per your request.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the County of Salem to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council ("GRC") by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The Council can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
