Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

I, Heather Scherbinski, am a patrolman and Humane Law Enforcement Officer with the Howell Police Department. I have personally participated in this investigation and am aware of the facts contained herein. Because this statement is submitted for the limited purpose of establishing probable cause, I have not included herein the details of every aspect of this investigation. Statements attributable to individuals are related in substance and in part, except where otherwise indicated. On Monday, May 18, 2020, P.P. found the bodies of two burned puppies in a fire pit on property belonging to his brother, S.P., at 989 Route 33, Howell, New Jersey. P.P. notified S.P., who contacted Howell Township Police Department. S.P. advised that on or about May 1, 2020, defendant Daniel McDonald, Jr. a former employee of S.P., contacted S.P. and indicated he needed a place to stay. S.P. told defendant if he had a trailer, he could park it on his property in Howell and live in the trailer. On or about May 7, 2020, defendant began living in a trailer at 989 Route 33 in Howell. S.P. advised he observed the defendant to be in possession of three German Shepherd puppies that were black and tan in color and approximately seven weeks old.

On or about the morning of Saturday, May 16, 2020, defendant informed S.P., that two of the puppies died. He told S.P. that when he woke up that morning there was blood and diarrhea all over his trailer and the two puppies were dead. Defendant told S.P. that he wrapped the puppies in a towel and buried them in the woods. Defendant mentioned the puppies having Parvo virus. Upon hearing this, S.P. took possession of the third puppy, which was still alive. S.P. indicated that he saw two of the puppies the prior day, and that the two puppies that were now dead looked healthy. According to S.P., later in the afternoon on May 16, 2020, defendant's girlfriend, T.J., called S.P. T.J. told S.P. about a domestic argument she had with defendant the prior night. T.J. indicated that defendant was drunk and got mad at her because she could not get the pickup truck into park. Defendant used his backhoe to flip the pickup truck and damage it until it was totaled. After damaging this truck, T.J. told S.P. he grabbed the puppies and threw them in the fire pit. During the defendants video recorded statement, he advised that he received five puppies from a farm in Montgomery Township. (See continuation in box #3)

3. If victim was injured, provide the extent of the injury:

Under his care four of the puppies died, all while gasping for air and foaming from the mouth without seeking veterinary medical attention.

He states he buried the first two puppies that died behind his camper on the property of 989 Route 33. With respect to the next two puppies he woke up and found the first puppy dead after seeing it struggling to breath the night prior. He then saw the fourth puppy gasping for air his fiancée in distress over the puppy. He then advised he refused to get it medical attention because of the costs associated with the care. He then stated he threw them outside and they "luckily" landed into the fire pit. Bodies of two of the puppies were recovered in the fire pit and the other two were dug up behind the trailer.

With the assistance of South Brunswick Police, it was learned that the defendant was in possession of a stolen Honda EU3000i generator that was

OFFICER VELLA RECEIVED INFORMATION THAT THE DEF. MAY HAVE BEEN RESPONSIBLE FOR THE THEFT AND IN POSSESSION OF THE STOLEN FRONT END LOADER. IT WAS AT THAT TIME, OFFICER VELLA CONTACTED OUR AGENCY AND INQUIRED ABOUT THE DEFENDANT. DISPATCH RAN THE DEFENDANT THROUGH RECORDS AND READ THE REPORT REGARDING THE ANIMAL CRUELTY CASE (20-20880) AND LEARNED THAT THE DEF. WAS IN POSSESSION OF A FRONT END LOADER (AKA: BACKHOE) AND CONTACTED ME.

I RESPONDED TO 989 RT. 33. AND FOUND THE FRONT END LOADER PARKED IN THE SAME LOCATION AS I OBSERVED ON MAY 20, 2020. I HAD DISPATCH RUN THE VIN NUMBER AND CONFIRMED THAT IT WAS THE SAME VIN FROM THE FRONT END LOADER STOLEN FROM MONROE TWP. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT DEF WAS NO PRESENT AS HE IS CURRENTLY LODGED IN THE MONMOUTH COUNTY JAIL.

THE FRONT END LOADED WAS REMOVED AS A STOLEN VEHICLE AND WAS RETURNED TO THE OWNER, JAMES CRAIG.

Purpose: This Affidavit/Certification is to more fully describe the facts of the alleged offense so that a judge or authorized judicial officer may determine probable cause.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On May 20, 2020, defendant Daniel McDonald was charged on Warrant 2020-000290-1319 with four counts of third-degree Animal Cruelty for purposely, knowingly, or recklessly failing to provide four German Shepherd puppies with necessary care, resulting in the puppies' deaths. He was also charged with four counts of Hindering Apprehension of Oneself, disorderly persons offenses, for concealing or destroying the remains of the four puppies.

The investigation into this matter continued after defendant's arrest. Defendant stated during his interview that he got the puppies from a farm off "518/"206" in the Montgomery area and that the mother neglected them. Officer Magliozzo of the MCSPCA attempted to locate the farm where defendant allegedly obtained the puppies. Officer Magliozzo obtained information from Lt. Jason Muller of the Jamesburg Police Department regarding a farm located at 90 Georgetown Road in Franklin Township, NJ., which was suspected to be the farm in question. Officer Magliozzo responded to the farm and learned that the farm owner, D.D., reported 5 German Shepherd puppies were recently stolen from his farm and that he filed a report with the Franklin Township Police Department.

The police report indicates that D.D. reported on May 19, 2020, that defendant and his fiancé, Tricia Jaccoma, were looking for a place to work and stay. The defendant and Tricia helped out on the farm until recently when they left abruptly overnight. After they left, items on the farm started to go missing, including five German Shepherd puppies. D.D. indicated that the 5 puppies, which were approximately three weeks old, and a heat lamp went missing from the farm approximately a week prior. The farm owner reported he believed who ever stole the puppies were familiar with the mother because she was extremely protective. It should be noted that while the Franklin Township report refers to three puppies being stolen, Detective Hernandez from that agency indicated there was a mistake in the report and the farm owner advised that in fact 5 puppies had been stolen.

Four of the puppies were located deceased in Howell Township (the subjects of the animal cruelty charges in W-2020-00290-1319). Defendant admitted being in possession of the puppies and disposing of their bodies. The fifth puppy had been in defendant's possession but is alive and in the custody of the owner of the property in Howell where defendant had been staying.

Officer Maglizzo, of the MCSPCA, investigation revealed this information from the statements made by the victim and the police report taken by Franklin Township Police Department.

3. If victim was injured, provide the extent of the injury:

(continuation of box #1) D.M. stated during his interview that he and defendant were in possession of 5 German Shepherd puppies at his trailer which had been parked on property located at 989 Route 33 in Howell. D.M. stated that 4 of the puppies got sick and died. During D.M.'s interview, he stated the defendant was consoling the puppies during the time they were gasping for air and foaming at the mouth just prior to their death. D.M. admitted burying two puppies behind the trailer and throwing the other two puppies into a fire pit near the trailer. These 4 deceased puppies were the located on the property, and were the subjects of the animal cruelty charges in W-2020-00290-1319. The fifth puppy had been in D.M.'s and the defendant's possession but is alive and in the custody of the owner of the property in Howell where defendant had been staying, S.P. S.P also observed defendant and D.M. to be in possession of the 5 puppies.

1. Description of relevant facts and circumstances which support probable cause that (1) the offense(s) was committed and (2) the defendant is the one who committed it:

On or about May 20, 2020, D.M. was charged under W-2020-00290-1319 with four counts of third-degree animal cruelty for purposely, knowingly, or recklessly failing to provide necessary care to four German Shepherd puppies, resulting in the puppies' deaths. D.M. was also charged with four counts of Hindering Apprehension of Oneself, disorderly persons offenses, for concealing or destroying the remains of the four puppies.

During his statement, D.M. indicated that he and defendant, Tricia Jaccoma, who he refers to as his "fiancé/wife", obtained 5 puppies from a farm off of 518/206 in the Montgomery area and that their mother neglected them. D.M. indicated that defendant had a connection to the farm. D.M. indicated that defendant wanted the puppies and that under the care of him and defendant, four of the puppies died, all while gasping for air and foaming from the mouth without seeking veterinary medical attention. McDonald indicated that he buried the first two puppies that died behind his camper on the property of 989 Route 33 in Howell. McDonald indicated that the next two puppies then died and he threw them into the fire pit behind his camper while defendant was present in the camper.

After D.M. was charged, Officer Magliozzo of the Monmouth County Society for the Prevention of Cruelty of Animals located the farm where D.M. and defendant obtained the puppies, at 90 Georgetown Road in Franklin Township, NJ. Officer Magliozzo learned that the farm owner, D.D., reported 5 German Shepherd puppies, approximately three weeks old, were recently stolen from his farm and that he filed a report with the Franklin Township Police Department. Prior to the puppies being stolen, D.M. and defendant had been staying on his farm. D.M. and defendant were subsequently charged on Warrants 2020-335-1319 and 2020-336-1319 with five counts of third-degree Receiving Stolen Property, one for each puppy.

Necropsy examinations of the two buried puppies revealed that they were "emaciated", "severely malnourished" and that there were "no indications of recent nutritional ingestion". The necropsy examinations further revealed that the puppies suffered from Coccidia. One puppy had roundworm and the other had pneumonia. Necropsies were unable to be performed on the two puppies whose bodies were burned in the fire pit.

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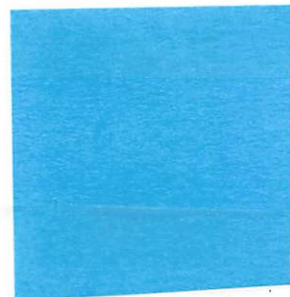

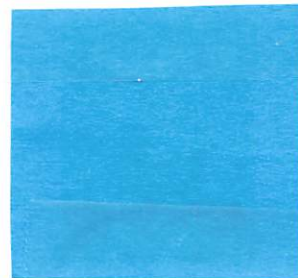

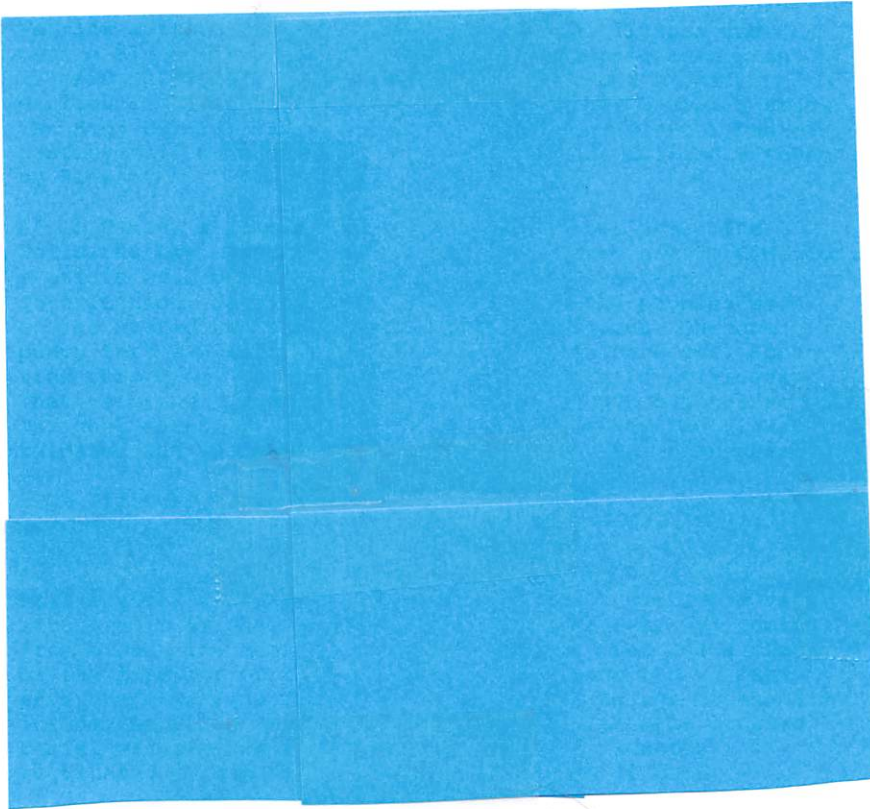
