Response to Common Law Request

The common law right to access public records depends on three requirements: (1) the records must be common law public documents; (2) the person seeking access must establish an interest in the subject matter of the material; and (3) the citizen's right to access must be balanced against the State's interest in preventing disclosure. *Richard Rivera v. Union County*

Prosecutor's Office, 250 N.J. 124, 143-44 (2022); *South Jersey Publishing Co. v. New Jersey Expressway Auth.*, 124 N.J. 478, 487 (1991); *Loigman v. Kimmelman*, 102 N.J. 98 (1986); *Nero v. Hyland*, 76 N.J. 213, 222 (1978).

After consultation with the Borough records attorney, we have determined that you have failed to establish a proper interest in the requested records. Your common law request is therefore denied.
