The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County. If you should have any questions regarding the case, please feel free to contact this law enforcement agency.

1. OPERATION OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE

The operation of the involved motor vehicle was observed by a witness who contacted this agency to report same. Please reference the Supplementary Incident Report completed by Patrol Officer Licknack #110 in reference to this incident which contains the witness observation and statements.

2. WHEN STOPPED OR ARRIVAL AT SCENE

Patrol Officer Johnson #131 first arrived at Quickchek and observed the accused vehicle, a gray 2015 Mazda 6 [NJ - SBK83P], parked in the parking stall near the vacuum hoses. Ptl. Johnson approached the accused vehicle and made contact with the driver, Corie Messner, and advised her the reason for patrol interaction. I arrived on scene moments later and accompanied Ptl. Johnson, who was obtaining Ms. Messner's identification. I conducted a walk around of the accused vehicle and discovered damage to the rear passenger wheel and a puncture to the rear passenger tire.

Patrols conducted an investigation, but were unable to determine if Ms. Messner was involved in a motor vehicle crash due to being unable to determine if and where it occurred.

I returned to the driver side of the vehicle and could immediately detect the odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from the interior of Ms. Messner's vehicle. I further observed that Ms. Messner had dilated pupils, bloodshot eyes and produced a slurred speech.

I began speaking with Ms. Messner who explained that she was coming from the Dublin House located in Red Bank, New Jersey where she consumed two to three drinks of straight Jameson Irish Whiskey. Ms. Messner stated that she was traveling home from the bar and did not make any stops along the way. Ms. Messner confirmed that she was the operator and only operator of this vehicle throughout her travels from Red Bank to Eatontown.

I requested Ms. Messner step out of her vehicle and inquired about her participation in a Standardized Field Sobriety Test. Ms. Messner agreed to take part in the tests and stepped out of her vehicle. Once outside of the vehicle, Ms. Messner clarified that she was currently wearing contact lenses and had the ability to see clearly and was not suffering from any physical injury that would effect her balance or ability to stand and move.

I began with the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus (HGN) test. I provided Ms. Messner with instructions how to perform and complete the test which she acknowledged and verbally stated that she understood. I had to relay these instructions to Ms. Messner twice and requested she physically touch the tip of the flashlight that I was using to complete this test to verify that she understood. While performing this test, I did not observe resting Nystagmus, but did observe a lack of smooth pursuit. Ms. Messner did not follow the flashlight to maximum deviation as instructed therefore I did not observe Nystagmus at maximum deviation. Ms. Messner's eyes did display Nystagmus at the onset of 45 degrees. I finally performed the Vertical Gaze Nystagmus (VGN) test which Ms. Messner's eyes did not display.

The second test was the Walk and Turn. I instructed Ms. Messner on what's known as the starting position and demonstrated same. I requested Ms. Messner enter this position, but she was unable to without losing her balance. She made several attempts to enter this position and was apologetic for being unable to do so. Eventually, after many failed attempts, Ms. Messner began the walk and turn test without starting from the starting position as instructed. During her demonstration, she was unable to maintain a straight line while walking, extended her arms away from her body for balance, did not step heel-to-toe, and miscounted. Ms. Messner reset and was provided another opportunity to complete the test. During her second demonstration, Ms. Messner extended her arms away from her body for balance, did not step heel-to-toe, completed more steps than instructed, and conducted an improper turn....

The accused vehicle approached the intersection with Wyckoff Road and made a right turn after the traffic signal turned green. While driving on Wyckoff Road, the accused vehicle was reportedly traveling at approximately 15 miles per hour, well below the posted speed limit (40 miles per hour). The accused vehicle eventually pulled into the QuickChek parking lot off of South Street, at which time William pulled over into a nearby parking lot to await this agency's arrival on location.
