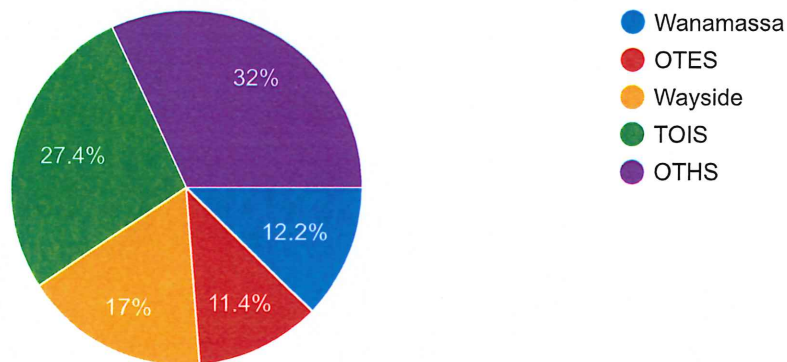

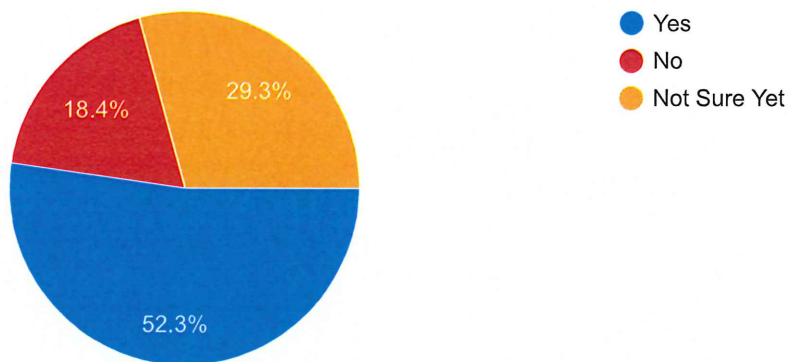

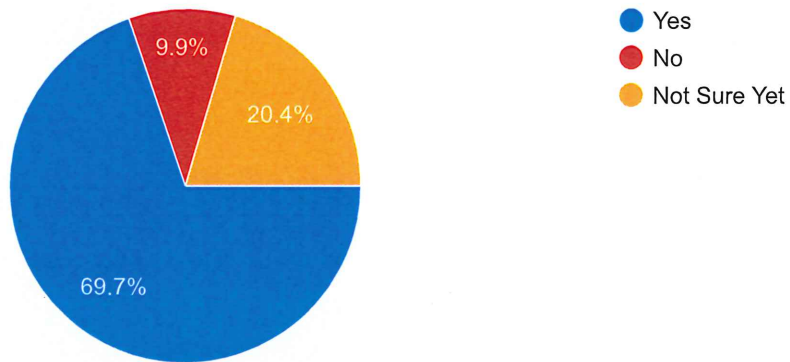
3. In September, will you send your child to school if our plan calls for all students to attend daily? This would require all students to wear face coverings at all times.

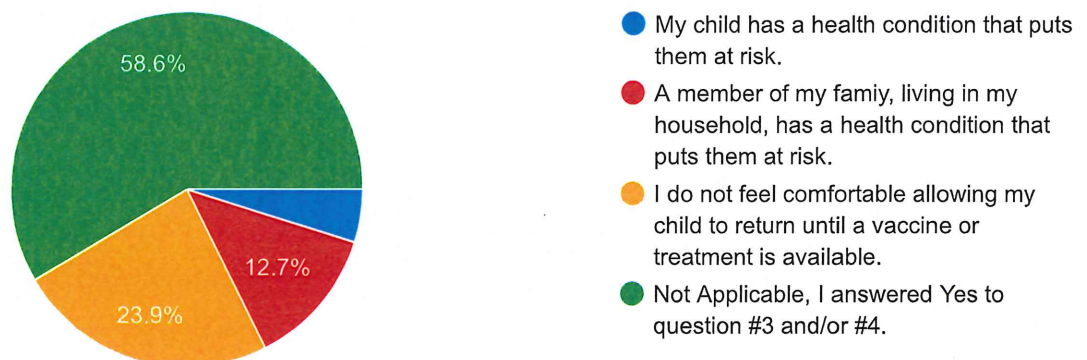

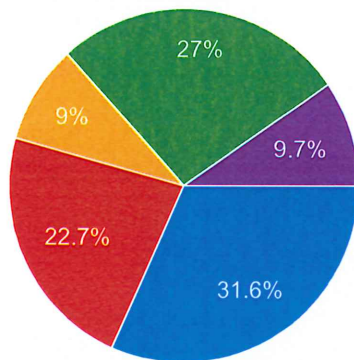

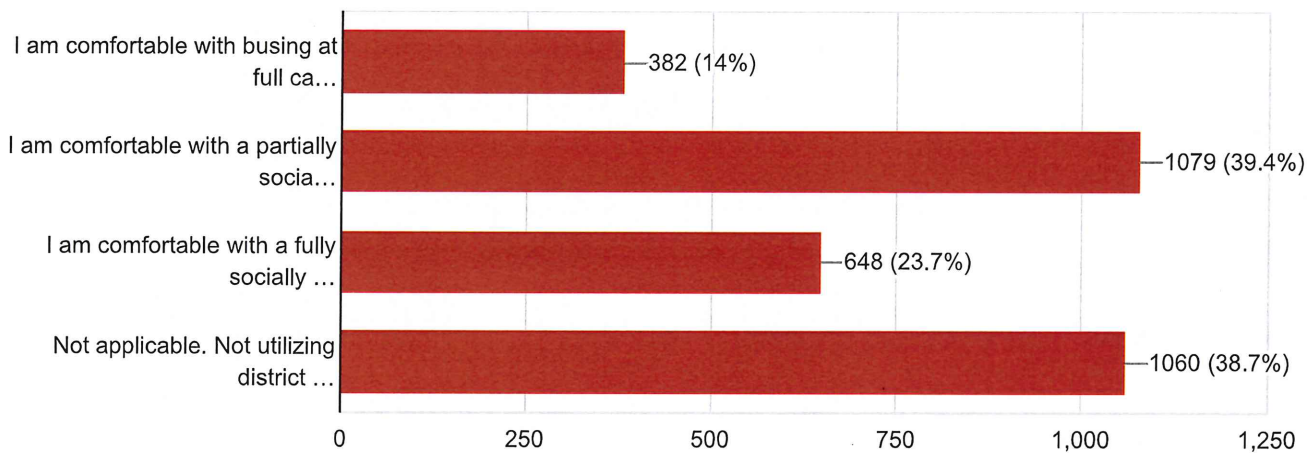

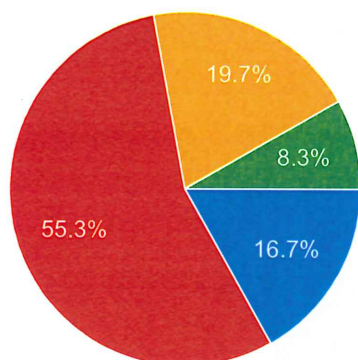

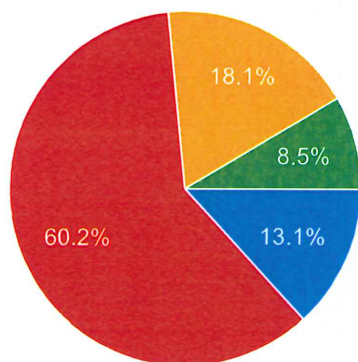

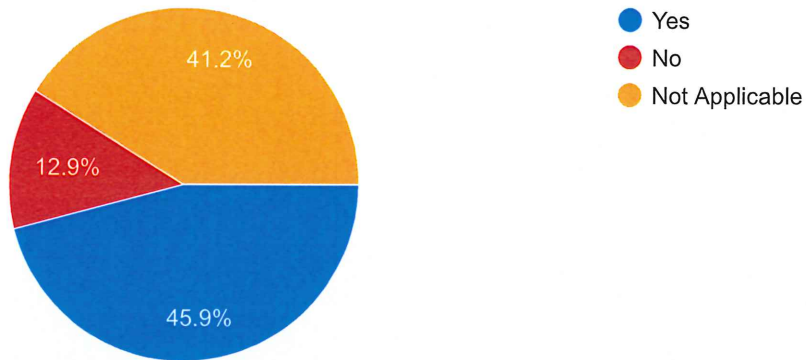

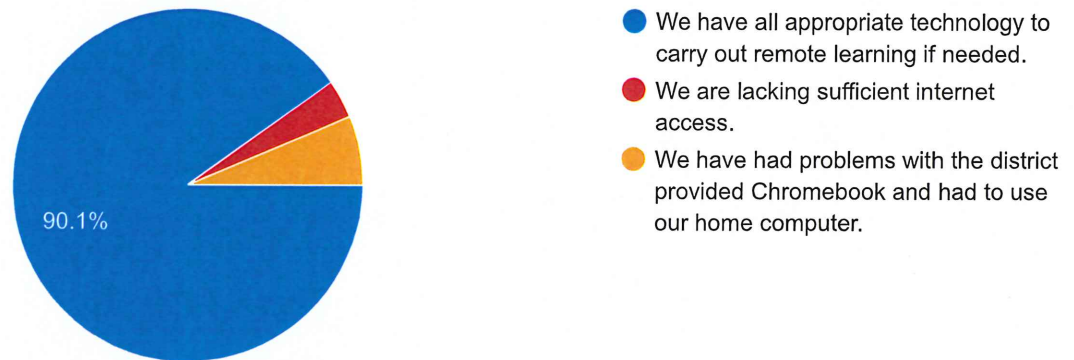
10. For childcare purposes, if you have multiple children in the district, do you need older siblings on the same hybrid schedule as younger siblings?

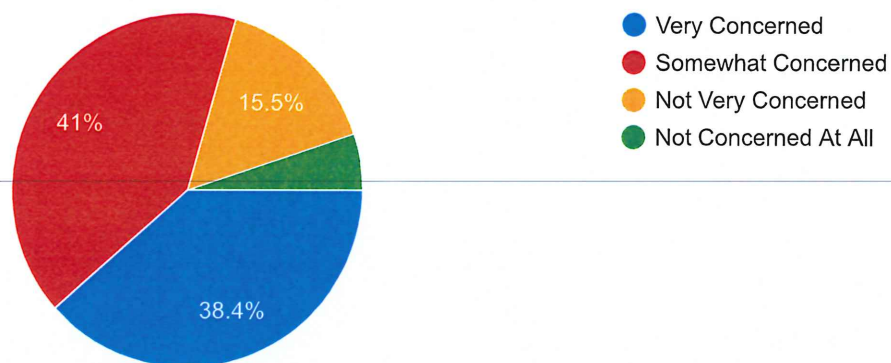

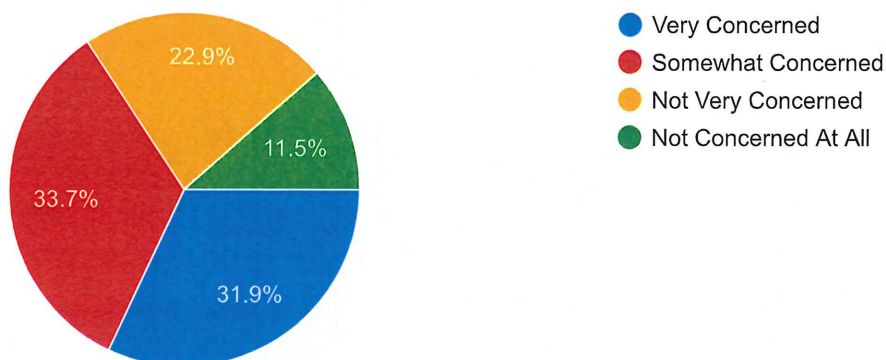
