Also only one item was attached their are multiple properties being actively rented on Pease lane. You have said that dave haaf is responsible for the inspection and the township meetings have indicated for many months now residents have been making complaints about the illegal occupancy on these properties,when will you start doing the legally required inspections? i have seen their have been over 19 different tenants in the last 4 months and not a single inspection from a township officer which seems like a major violation you guys are allowing to continue. the previously attached registration from 2018 says 66 pease lane is a 4 bedroom house , the ordinance regulating housing would indicate the maximum occupancy for renting would be 8 persons and 75 pease lane as 6 persons as it only a 3 bedroom correct?

prior clerk or do i need to talk to the housing officer directly? Your meeting minutes reflect that the township is aware that these proprieties having been regularly illegally rented for months now, why isn't the township pursuing violations as your Ordinance Regulating Rental Housing # 15-10 clearly states that registering the property doesn't grant permission to rent and that it is the issuance of Housing Permit which is only issued upon compliance with the ordinances sub sections .
