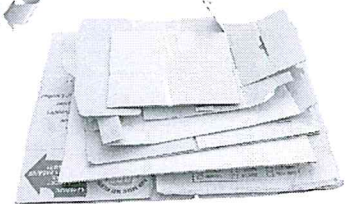

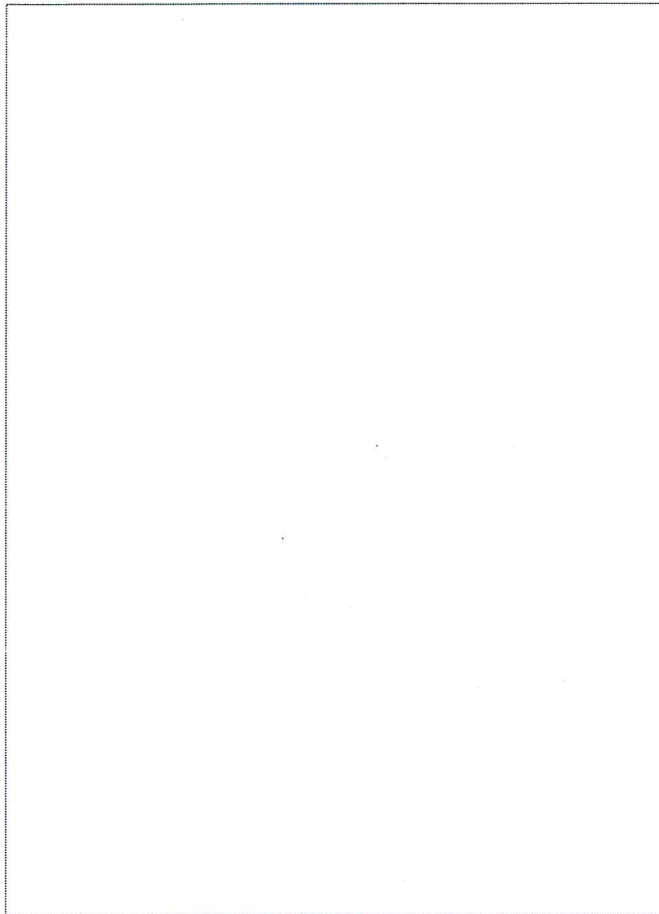
The Town of Gilbert, AZ invited residents to share their holiday light displays via the town's citizen request management tool, SeeClickFix.

This month marks the 25th anniversary of the Northridge Earthquake that struck in the early morning hours on Jan. 17, 1994. The magnitude-6.7 blind thrust earthquake struck Northridge, Calif.; caused widespread chaos through building and freeway collapses; claimed the lives of 57 people; and caused billions of dollars in damage. Today, there's a 60-percent chance an earthquake measuring in at magnitude 6.7 or higher will strike the Los Angeles area in the next 30 years and officials estimate that thousands of Southern California buildings still remain vulnerable and are at risk of collapse during a seismic event. This clearly demonstrates the importance of regular updates to the building codes and strong code enforcement in order to mitigate damage from natural disasters such as earthquakes. [Read more](#)
