You sent your opra request via email on Tuesday, September 5, 2023, at 10:39pm, which is after normal business hours. The Custodian of Records received via email your request on Wednesday, September 6, 2023 which was the next business day. Therefore, the seven (7) business day deadline is Thursday, September 15, 2023.

Your OPRA request seeks access to the following:

Please provide copies of all deleted Facebook comments from the Lavallette Police Department Facebook page from the period of July 24th, 2023 to September 5th, 2023.

Your request requires additional time beyond the seven (7) business days to fulfill. OPRA allows custodians to seek extensions of time pursuant to N.J.S.A. 47:1A-5.i. Specifically, OPRA states that, "the requestor shall be advised by the custodian when the record can be made available. If the record is not made available by that time, access shall be deemed denied."

Your request requires an extension of time no later than December 15, 2023.

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the [insert name of Agency] to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
