The Sussex County Prosecutor's Office, Firearms Training Unit, conducted firearms qualification training, as per the New Jersey Attorney General Guidelines, in April and October 2017. These sessions were conducted at the Sussex County Public Safety Training Academy, in their indoor range facility.

During the course of training in April, Use of Force Policies and Procedures were reviewed, via PowerPoint presentation. During both qualification sessions all current detective staff, at the time of training, completed a 50 round day and 40 round night qualification course of fire and all detective staff passed without need for remediation.

All detectives assigned a shotgun completed the required day and night shotgun qualification course and all detectives passed without need for remediation.

All detectives assigned an M-4 Carbine are required to complete 4 qualifications, two, full 60 round courses of fire and two 10 round courses of fire for this firearm. These qualifications were held in April (60 round), June (10 round), August (60 round) and November (10 round). All detectives qualified as required, without need for remediation.
