PO Tulko and I then proceeded to pursue the vehicle Rt 9nb. The SUV exited onto Bordentown Ave in Sayreville. The SUV turned off its lights on Bordentown Ave. As I turned onto Bordentown Ave I can see brake lights illuminate near the Parkway Service Center. I checked the area with negative results. The pursuit was then terminated.

As I pulled into the parking lot for the dealership, the suspect vehicle fled to Route 9 north. I gave chase topping out at 103 MPH. The suspect's speed was in excess of 103 MPH. The suspect vehicle exited Route 9 and turned onto Bordentown Ave. I lost sight of the suspect vehicle. It most likely went onto the GSP via the park and ride off Bordentown Ave. Pursuit was terminated.
