ON 9/22/15 HQ ADVISED MANALAPAN P.D. WAS ATTEMPTING TO STOP A VEHICLE ENTERING OUR TOWN. THE REASON FOR THE STOP WAS FAILURE TO MAINTAIN LANE. WHILE I WAS POSITIONED (103) ON RT 9 AND SCHULMEISTER RD. I OBSERVED MANALAPAN P.D. PASS MY LOCATION, I COULD HEAR AND SEE THEIR LIGHTS AND SIRENS. I FOLLOWED BEHIND WITH MY LIGHTS AND SIRENS ACTIVATED MAINTAINING A SAFE DISTANCE AND SPEED. AS THE SUSPECT VEHICLE APPROACHED RT 9 AND PERRINE RD. THEY WERE BLOCKED IN BY SEVERAL TRACTOR TRAILERS. FORCING THEM TO STOP. I STOPPED IN THE CENTER LANE TO PROVIDE OFFICER SAFETY. PO. WHITEHILL #91 TOOK THE DRIVER INTO CUSTODY.

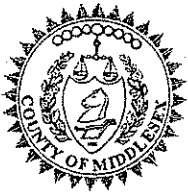

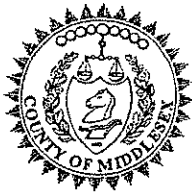

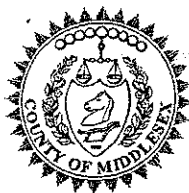

WHILE ON PATROL, I WAS DISPATCHED TO A MV CRASH, WITH IT RELAYED THAT THE INVOLVED VEHICLES HAD PULLED INTO QUICK CHECK (1 MORRISTOWN RD.). AS I APPROACHED THE AREA, SEVERAL PPL ALERTED ME TO THE DEFENDANT'S VEHICLE, WHICH HAD FLED THE PARKING LOT AND STRUCK ANOTHER VEHICLE. I ACTIVATED MY LIGHTS AND POSITIONED BEHIND THE VEHICLE WHICH THEN REVERSED AND CHANGED LANE, PROCEEDING WB ON MORRISTOWN RD. I ACTIVATED MY SIREN, FOLLOWING THE VEHICLE AS IT TURNED ONTO BAUMGARD DR. (RESIDENTIAL). THE DRIVER CONTINUED THROUGH THE DEVELOPMENT, TURNING ONTO HALLANDALE DR. AND THEN GULFSTREAM BLVD. 30. Detailed Narrative:

On Saturday March 19, 2016 at approximately 0047 hrs I was running RADAR on RT9 in the American Shred Builders lot. He advised that Marlboro PD was attempting to stop a MV, but did not give any vehicle description.

While waiting to see if Marlboro needed assistance, I observed a light green colored Nissan Altima traveling at 111 mph. As I entered RT9 to attempt a MV stop, the driver turned off the vehicle's headlights and continued driving at or above 111 mph. I activated my emergency lights and attempted to close the distance.

While attempting to close the distance, I observed the Altima change lanes without signaling from the left lane across three lanes into the shoulder and pass trucks on the right. The vehicle then ran the red traffic signals at RT9 & Wake Barn at RT9 & Old Mill Rd. without attempting to stop. I finally was able to close the distance at RT9 & Downing St. I advised HQ that the vehicle's registration was NJ-Y54EMH. I was ordered to terminate by LT CAVASIN. 30. Detailed Narrative: On 04/21/2016 DSgt. P. LoPresti, Det. B. Mazalewski, Det. G. Bracht and I conducted a buy/bust operation from a known illegal narcotics dealer, Russell A. Hardy. While attempting to arrest Hardy for the crime of narcotics distribution and possession he avoided apprehension by fleeing the scene in a 1999 Honda Accord (NJ Reg. R43-GMN) as Det. Bracht and I closed in on his vehicle. While exiting the parking lot Hardy drove head-on toward DSgt. LoPresti who had activated his emergency lights to make the stop. Hardy disregarded DSgt. LoPresti and got onto Route 9 South. I activated my emergency lights and siren and attempted to stop Hardy, but he refused to pull over. I followed Hardy at speeds between 60-65 mph as he traveled in the left lane toward Route 34 South. Hardy was straddling both the left lane and the exit lane toward Route 34 South. Unable to safely negotiate the curve I had stopped in the left lane on Route 9 South after by-passing the exit. I observed Hardy lose control of his vehicle in the gravel then head toward Det. Bracht, who was attempting to back me up on the stop. Det. Bracht's car struck the guard rail as he tried to avoid a collision with Hardy. The pursuit ended and Hardy fled the area.
