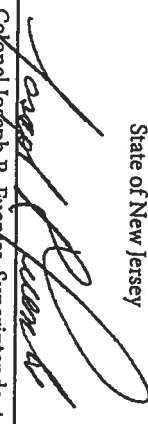

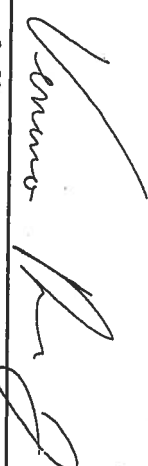

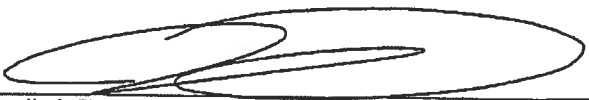
Bi-annual recertification:

- ② CRIMINAL APPREHENSION - DECOY STANDING APPROX 15 FEET AWAY, HANDLER ISSUED VERBAL COMMANDS AND RELEASED K-9. K-9 VERBALLY RELEASED FROM DECOY.
- ③ HANDLER PROTECTION. NO ASSAULT. K-9 PLACED IN A STAY/SIT. HANDLER CONDUCTED A PAT DOWN OF DECOY AND RETURNED TO K-9. K-9 REMAINED IN A SIT.
- ④ BUILDING SEARCH. K-9 WAS PLACED IN A STACK FORMATION WITH 4 OFFICERS AND A BALLISTIC SHIELD. A WARNING ANNOUNCEMENT WAS GIVEN AND K-9 RELEASED OFF LEAD. AS K-9 CLEARED DOORS THE TEAM MOVED FORWARD. K-9 WAS RECALLED BACK TO THE STACK MULTIPLE TIMES SO THE TEAM COULD CONTINUE. 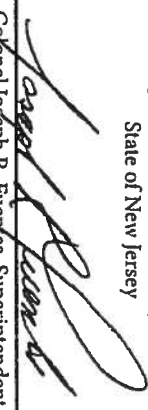

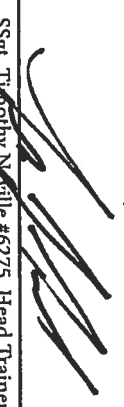
