2. I seek a copy of the police department's Public Synopsis of Disciplinary Actions for the year 2018. This report is required pursuant to Requirement 10 of the Attorney General's Internal Affairs Police.
3. I seek a copy of the police department's Vehicular Pursuit Summary Reports for the year 2018.
4. I would like all of your police department's Use of Force Reports from January 1, 2019 to January 31, 2019.
5. I would like all of your police department's Police Use of Deadly Force Attorney General Deadly Notification Reports for the year 2018.

You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
