Each agency also shall periodically release a brief synopsis of all complaints where a fine or suspension of ten (10) days or more was assessed to an agency member. This synopsis shall not contain the identities of the officers or complainants, but should briefly outline the nature of the transgression and the fine or suspension imposed.



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
