Dear Time to Change- Jersey Style,

The Borough of Eatontown Municipal Clerk received your OPRA request for records on November 20, 2017, the official Police Records Custodian James Rolly, received your request on November 20, 2017. A response to your request was provided to you on November 30, 2017 the 6th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request. On December 1, 2017 you sent a request for additional records.

Your additional request sought access to the following:

Does your law enforcement agency have any sort of records, documentation, attendance records that would show that the police officers received the training that I mentioned in #6. If so, I would like the name of any documentation in order for me to request them from your agency.

6. I seek the annual basic police academy training, annual firearms requalification training, use of force training, vehicular pursuit training, domestic violence training, cultural diversity training, bias intimidation crimes training, Breathalyzer training, 911 dispatcher and call-taker training, K-9 training recertification certificates for all of the police officers in your police department for the year 2017.

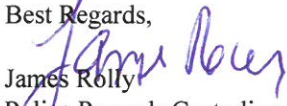

This agency does not possess any records, documentation, attendance records that would show that police officers received the training in the following;

- 6.1 Annual basic police academy training
- 6.8 Breathalyzer Training
- 6.9 911 dispatcher and call-taker training
- 6.10 K-9 training

If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Eatontown Police Department to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
