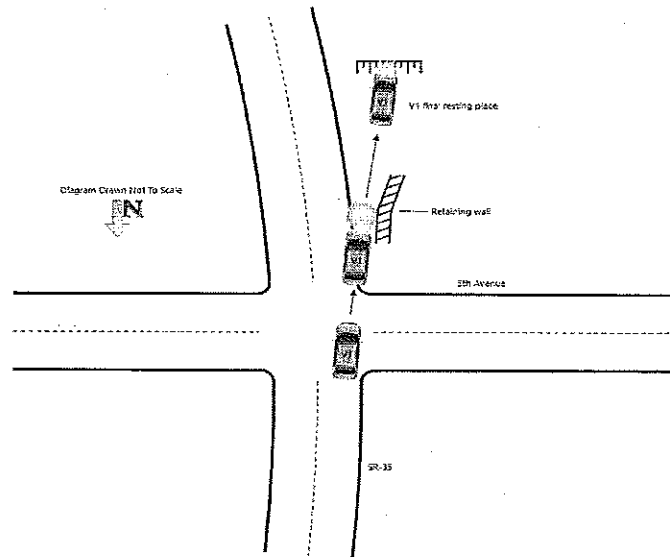

Box 118A: Driver #1 stated that he was unaware the events leading up to the collision. He believed that he lost control of the vehicle while attempting to pass turning vehicle's but could not confirm the same.

Box 126C: Block retaining wall

I responded to the scene of a motor vehicle accident involving (1) vehicle. Vehicle #1 was traveling southbound along SR-35 approaching the intersection of 5th Avenue. The cause of the accident is unknown at this time due to Driver #1's confused stated of mind and no witnesses present. Driver #1 informed me that he believes he was attempting to pass turning vehicle's when he lost control of his vehicle but could not confirm the same. Note: It was raining at the time of the collision.

As Driver #1 was traveling southbound along SR-35, he lost control of his vehicle. As a result, Vehicle #1 struck and mounted the western curb along SR-35. After striking the curb, Vehicle #1 then struck a traffic sign support causing the same to dismantle. The passenger side headlight and front passenger side tire then struck a block retaining wall. Vehicle #1 remained in motion traveling along the grass before striking a dirt embankment before reaching its final resting place.

Vehicle #1 sustained disabling damage to the front bumper, driver side headlight, passenger side headlight, both passenger side tires as well as undercarriage damage. Atlantic Auto Recovery responded to the scene and removed Vehicle #1. Driver #1 did not complain of or have any visible signs of injury; he declined medical attention.
