145. Crash Description/Narrative

V1 was making a lane change from the Route 1 entrance ramp from Milltown Road to the right lane of Route 1 North. V2 was traveling in the right lane of Route 1 North.

D2 stated while driving, V1 side swiped the passenger side of his vehicle and continued driving Route 1 North bound never stopping. D2 was able to take a picture of V1 that fled which appeared to be an older model Ford F150 black in color bearing a NJ reg: C89MAZ. D2 stated a female was driving the vehicle. Witness David on scene stated he observed a large black pick up truck bearing NJ reg: C89MAZ side swipe the passenger side of V2 while changing lanes to the right lane of Route 1 North and continued driving after striking V2. No driver description of V1 was given by David.

Officers on scene investigation reveals D1 is at fault for unsafe speed during unsafe road conditions.

V2 sustained disabling damage to the passenger side and was towed from scene by Coppa's. No injuries were reported on scene.

145 Crash Description

A DMV inquiry of the license plate given by D2 and David revealed V1 to comeback to a red Ford X18 registered to a female residing in Jamesburg. Jamesburg PD conducted a follow up at the residence and was able to give me a contact number for the registered party who was not home at the time. I then called the female who advised she has not been home since 0700 hours and that her roommate just informed her that her vehicle was missing from the front of the house. The female stated she has a magnetic lock box under the truck where she keeps a spare key and that is how her truck must have been stolen. She failed to report her truck stolen to Jamesburg PD as she was at work earlier and in New Brunswick. She was advised to report the truck stolen immediately to Jamesburg PD. As of now, there is no suspect for the driver of V1 and no vehicle information for V1 as it appears the license plate attached to V1 appeared to fictitious or the license stolen.
