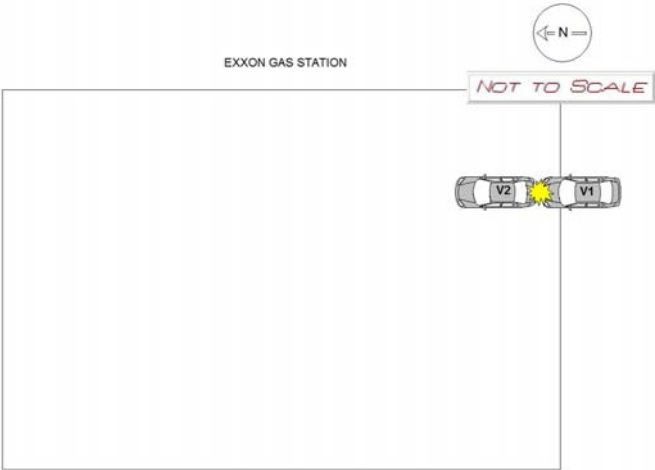
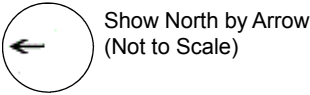

145 Crash Description

D1 STATED IN EFFECT WHILE STOPPED IN THE EXXON PARKING LOT TO GET GAS, V2 BACKED UP INTO HER VEHICLE CAUSING VERY MINOR DAMAGE TO HER FRONT BUMPER. SHE ADVISED ME THAT THE VEHICLE WAS A DARK COLORED PICK-UP TRUCK, POSSIBLY A FORD.

I SPOKE WITH THE MANAGER OF THE EXXON GAS STATION WHO WAS ABLE TO ACCESS THE VIDEO SURVEILLANCE CAMERAS. FROM THE FOOTAGE I WAS ABLE TO GET A LICENSE PLATE FROM THE SUSPECT VEHICLE (NJ Y14GUR). I OBSERVED A MALE DRIVING THE BLACK PICK-UP TRUCK AND REVERSE INTO V1. I CONTACTED THE REGISTERED OWNER OF THE VEHICLE, A FEMALE, WHO STATED THAT HER NEPHEW, ANGEL LOPEZ, WAS DRIVING THE VEHICLE. SHE KNEW NOTHING OF THE CRASH.

D2 WAS LATER CONTACTED AND ISSUES THE ABOVE SUMMONSES. HE WAS UNABLE TO PROVIDE ME WITH HIS INSURANCE INFORMATION.
