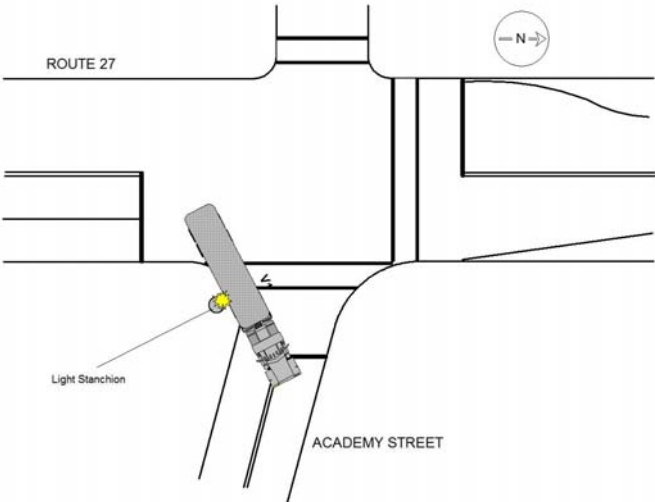
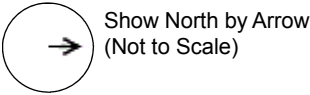

D1 STATED IN EFFECT, THAT HE WAS TRAVELLING NORTHBOUND ON RT 27 MAKING A RIGHT HAND TURN ONTO ACADEMY STREET. WHILE MAKING THE WIDE TURN HE NOTICED A VEHICLE WAS APPROACHING IN THE ONCOMING LANE SO HE MADE A SHARPER TURN THAN ORIGINALLY PLANNED TO AVOID THIS VEHICLE THAT HE HAD NOT SEEN PRIOR. AS A RESULT THE PASSENGER SIDE OF HIS TRAILER IMPACTED AND KNOCKED OVER THE LIGHT STANCHION. V1 WAS CARRYING 2 MOTOR VEHICLE'S ON ITS TRAILER WHICH WERE BOTH DAMAGED BY THE LIGHT STANCHION WHICH FELL ON TOP OF THEM. THE VIN NUMBERS FOR THOSE VEHICLES ARE 4JGDA5HB0GA780437 AND WDDHF8JB7GB233426.

MY INVESTIGATION REVEALED THAT D1 WAS AT FAULT. HE FAILED TO MAKE SURE THERE WAS PROPER SPACE TO MAKE A RIGHT HAND TURN AND AS A RESULT HIS VEHICLE (V1) IMPACTED THE LIGHT STANCHION WHICH WAS LOCATED ON THE CURB OUT OF THE ROADWAY.
