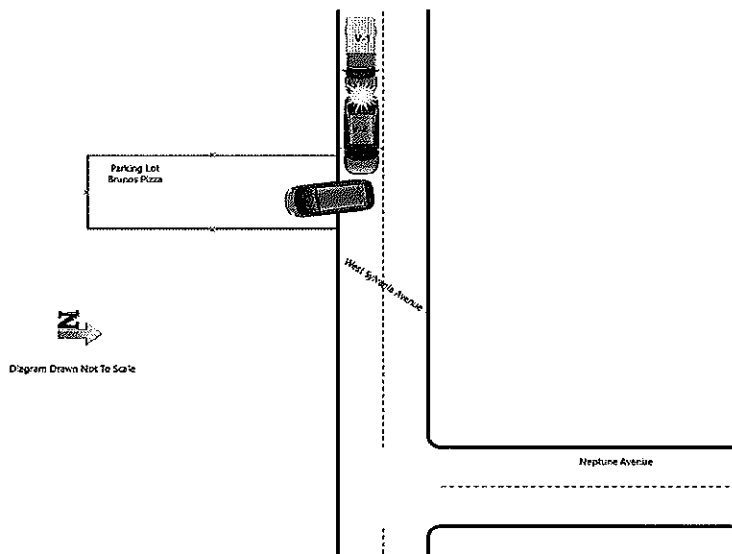

145 Crash Description/Narrative

Vehicle 2 was traveling east on West Sylvania Avenue. Vehicle 1 was traveling east on West Sylvania Avenue behind Vehicle 2. The driver of Vehicle 2 advised that a car in front of his vehicle made a last second right hand turn into the parking lot of Bruno's Pizza and Subs, located at 165 West Sylvania Avenue. The driver of Vehicle 2 began to slow down to avoid a collision with the vehicle in front of him. While slowing down, Vehicle 1 did not stop and hit vehicle 2 on its rear bumper, causing moderate damage. Vehicle 1 then fled the scene and was last seen making a left turn onto Neptune Avenue traveling north. The driver of Vehicle 2 was able to obtain Vehicle 1's registration (NJ L21KUG) which returned to a black 2001 Ford F150.

The driver of Vehicle 2 advised he was not injured. He was able to drive his vehicle back to his rental house in Belmar. While clearing the scene of the accident, Patrolman Edwards (#133) advised he located the accused vehicle parked on Bradley Street next to 50 Steiner Avenue. I responded there and observed the accused vehicle, which had sustained minor damage to its front bumper and grille. Patrols then made contact with the driver of Vehicle 1. At first he denied operating the vehicle and being involved in an accident. After further questioning, he eventually admitted he was driving his vehicle east on West Sylvania Avenue when the vehicle in front of him slammed on the brakes. The driver of Vehicle 1 advised he could not stop on time and struck Vehicle 2 on its rear bumper. The driver of Vehicle 1 advised he fled the scene because he did not have a drivers license. The driver of Vehicle 1 advised he was not injured. Dispatch confirmed that the driver of Vehicle 1 did not possess a valid drivers license. The driver of Vehicle 1 was issued multiple summonses for the following offenses and given a mandatory court date of July 15th at 9:00 AM with the Neptune City Municipal Court:

Unlicensed Driver (Never Possessed a License)
Leaving the Scene of an Accident
Failure to Report an Accident
