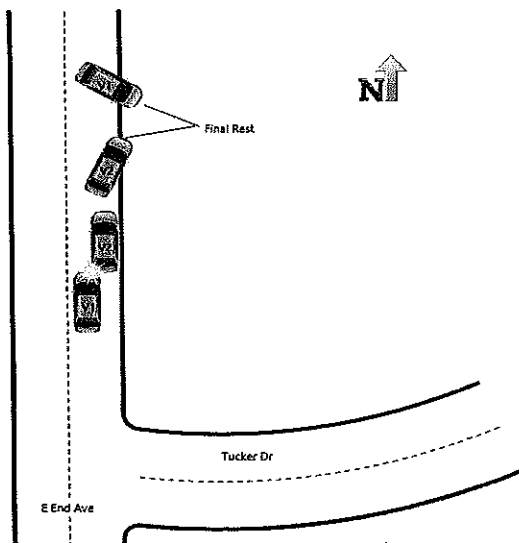

145 Crash Description/Narrative

Box #118a: D1 was not paying attention and drifted to the right, and struck V2.

V1 was traveling north on E End Ave. V2 was legally parked along the eastern curb of E End Ave, in front of 30 E End Ave. D1 was not paying attention and V1 drifted to the right, and struck V2. The front passenger fender of V1 struck the rear driver fender of V2. The force of the impact pushed V2 26 feet north from the point of impact, and spun V1 around 180 degrees, and came to a final uncontrolled rest 64 feet from the initial point of impact. Both vehicles struck and mounted the eastern curb, where both came to rest.

Both vehicles sustained disabling damage, and were towed by Bennett's Towing. NCOEM responded to the scene for fluid leaks from both vehicles.

D1 had a large laceration on the top of his head. While speaking with him regarding the crash, patrols detected an odor of an alcoholic beverage on his breath, his eyes were bloodshot and watery, he was slurring his words, and he had defecated on himself. Due to his apparent head injury, field sobriety tests were not performed. Mackay was transported to JSUMC by NCFAS. I responded to JSUMC, and spoke with Mackay, asking if he would consent to a blood draw, which he advised he would not.

A check of the driver's seatbelt in V1 showed it locked in the retracted position, indicating D1 was not wearing a seatbelt at the time of the crash. Further inspection of the cabin revealed a clump of hair, similar to D1's, stuck in the broken rearview mirror.

D1 was issued summonses for Careless Driving, 39:4-97, and Failure to Wear Seatbelt, 39:3-76.2f.
