

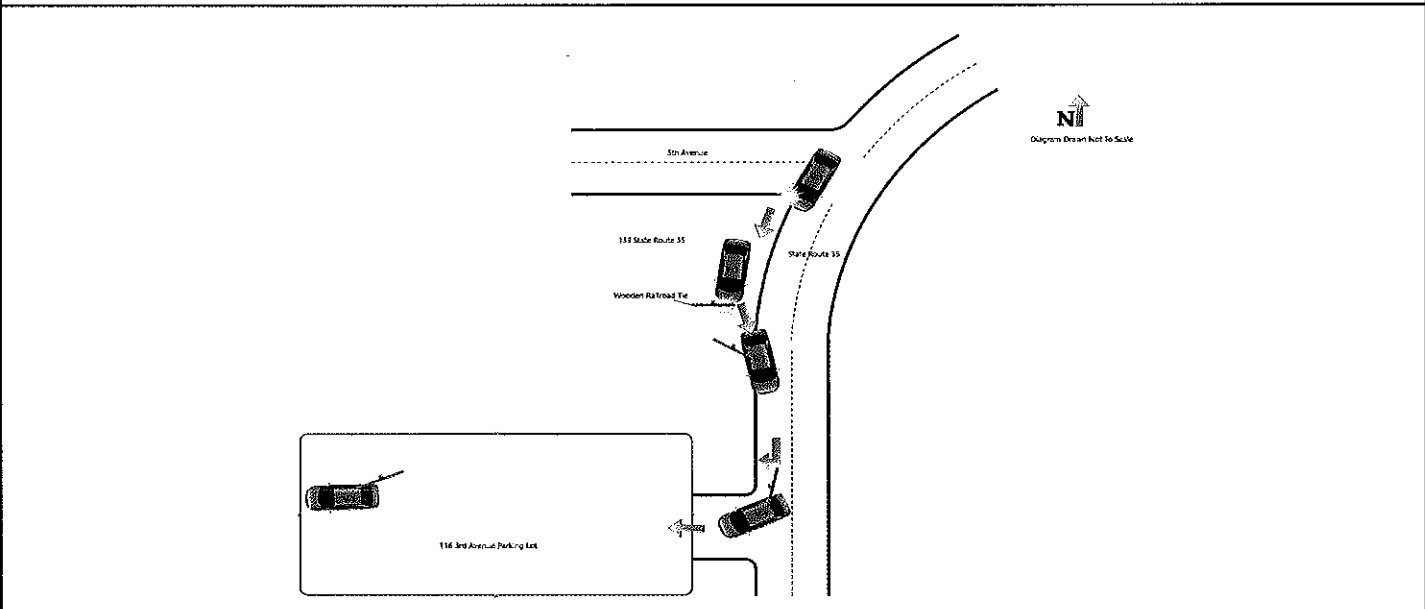

145 Crash Description/Narrative

Box 118A: Driver 1 stated he was not paying attention to the roadway and was tired due to working and lack of sleep.
Box 126B: Vehicle 1 struck a wooden railroad tie after striking the curb.

While patrolling the parking lot of 116 3rd Avenue, I observed a suspicious vehicle in the parking lot. The vehicle was parked in the northwestern corner of the parking lot facing west. Upon investigating the vehicle, I observed it had two flat tires on the passenger side of the vehicle. I also observed a large wooden railroad tie lodged underneath the vehicle directly in front of the rear passenger side tire. The vehicle's registration returned to a Wesley Sharpe who lives at 172 5th Avenue in Neptune City. Upon speaking with the owner of Vehicle 1 he denied that he was driving the vehicle and was involved in a motor vehicle accident. He advised his vehicle must have been stolen.

Upon clearing the owner of Vehicle 1's residence, I checked the surrounding area for signs of a motor vehicle accident. Upon checking near Route 35 and 5th Avenue, I observed tire marks in the front yard of the property located at 139 State Route 35. I also saw where a wooden railroad tie had been ripped from the ground. I observed drag marks going from the property of 139 State Route 35 back onto State Route 35 heading southbound. I followed the drag marks which showed the vehicle made a right turn into the parking lot located at 116 3rd Avenue. The drag marks ran through the parking lot heading west directly to where the vehicle was parked. The vehicle was disabled and towed from the scene by Bennett's towing to Jost Collision.

The next day I spoke with the owner of Vehicle 1. When asked again if he was involved in a motor vehicle accident he advised he was. Driver 1 stated he was traveling south on Route 35 approaching the intersection of 5th Avenue. Driver 1 stated he was tired and not fully focused on the road. Driver 1 advised he overshot the curve in the roadway and struck and mounted the curb at the intersection of Route 35 and 5th Avenue. Vehicle 1 then rode on the front yard of 139 State Route before striking a wooden railroad tie in the ground. Vehicle 1 then reentered the roadway back onto State Route 35 still

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traveling southbound. Vehicle 1 then turned right into the parking lot of 116 3rd Avenue heading west. Vehicle 1 then came to a stop in a parking spot located in the northwestern corner of the parking lot. The driver of Vehicle 1 then left his vehicle and returned to his residence. When asked why the driver of Vehicle 1 left the scene of the crash he advised he was afraid of getting tickets as a result of the crash.

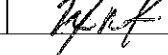
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
