Description of the Incident: CDS

On 11/24/2023, I Ptl. McLearen #24 was on routine patrol in the Borough of Englishtown. I was operating marked patrol unit #2, dressed in the Class A uniform, and had a body worn camera affixed to my chest. At approximately 00:55 Hours, I was parked stationary in the parking lot of 42 Main Street, and was facing the "T" intersection of Main Street and Water Street. While monitoring traffic, I observed a blue sedan (SC WQY495) travelling eastbound down Water Street. The vehicle came to the red light at the intersection with Main Street and came to a stop. When the light turned green, the vehicle sat still for approximately fifteen seconds and then made a right turn onto Main Street. After finishing the turn, I observed that the vehicle's rear license plate lights were not functioning (in violation of 39:3-66). I subsequently exited my location and began to follow the vehicle. The vehicle then approached the intersection of Main Street and Tennent Avenue, which had a red signal. As the vehicle slowed down, it ultimately came to a complete stop approximately one full car length past the white stop line (in violation of 39:4-105). As the traffic signal turned green, the vehicle then took a left turn onto Tennent Avenue. I proceeded behind the same and activated my overhead emergency lights when it became safe to do so, in order to effect a motor vehicle stop. The vehicle came to a complete stop in front of 7 Tennent Avenue.

Once stopped, I exited my patrol vehicle and approached the accused vehicle at the driver's side. I made contact with the driver, later identified as Owen Sullivan, and requested his drivers license, registration, and proof of insurance. Owen then handed me two registration cards and began looking for his drivers license. In doing so, Owen began searching the crevasse between the drivers seat and center console. I advised him to stop digging around, but he ignored my request and kept doing so. It should be noted that while speaking with Owen he appeared extremely nervous, more so than the average driver on a traffic stop, specifically by his hands shaking and him twitching. Owen then stopped reaching around and I began asking him questions regarding his destination. Owen stated that he had left South Carolina the day prior and was currently on route to New York for Thanksgiving with his family. I inquired how he ended up in Englishtown, and Owen stated that he went off of the Interstate and got lost. He then inquired with me where exactly he was and what state he was in.

Owen then began reaching around in the same area and I again told him to stop, to which he then looked at me and smiled and continued reaching. After telling him several more times to stop reaching, I then requested him to exit the vehicle. Owen then handed me his license that he found on the floorboard and began to question why I wanted him to exit. During this, Owen was twitching rapidly and had his car keys in his hand. Owen began looking at his ignition and put the keys close to it, as if he was preparing to flee from the stop. I then demanded him to exit, to which he then exited and was led to the rear of his vehicle. At this point, Ofc. Singh arrived on location in a backup capacity.

Once out of the vehicle, I advised Owen to turn around and place his hands on the trunk of his vehicle. I conducted a pat search for weapons, which yielded negative results. I then advised county dispatch of Owen's license number and had them conduct a check of the same for South Carolina and New Jersey. While waiting for a validity check, I began to question Owen on his behavior, thus far. Owen stated that he didn't believe I was a real police officer and that he thought people had been following him from a rest stop in Delaware. Due to Owen's

reaching around, I conducted a wingspan check for weapons of where he was seated, which yielded negative results. I then walked around the vehicle and shined my light into the same.

While doing so, I observed a cut plastic straw sitting in the cupholder. It should be noted that based off of my training and experience, I know cut straws are commonly used to ingest CDS through the nostril. I then retrieved the same and presented it to Owen. Owen stated that he did not know what it was. I asked if he ever uses CDS, and he stated that he is. I then asked if he ever uses CDS Cocaine, and he stated that he has in the past.

Based on the totality of circumstances thus far, I believed that additional contraband was inside of Owen's vehicle. I asked Owen if he would consent to a search of his motor vehicle, to which he stated that he would. I then retrieved a Consent to Search form from my vehicle and read the same verbatim to Owen. Owen signed the same, granting consent to a search of his vehicle. I then told Ofc. Singh to stand with Owen on the sidewalk while the search was being conducted. While searching, I located another cut straw which contained a white powder residue inside of it, consistent with CDS Cocaine, located on the front floorboard in between the drivers seat and door.

At this point, I advised Ofc. Singh to place Owen in handcuffs. Ofc. Singh then advised Owen to put his hands behind his back. Owen then became defensive and started asking why and I explained the same to him. During this, Owen was also looking around at his surroundings. It should be noted that this behavior is consistent with someone looking for an avenue of escape. Due to the same, I paused the search and walked over to the sidewalk. Owen's arms were crossed and he was still asking why he was going to be put in handcuffs. I then grabbed ahold of his right arm as Ofc. Singh grabbed the left. At this point, Owen lunged forward in an attempt to flee on foot. I quickly grabbed ahold of Owen from the back and we landed on the hood of his car. Ofc. Singh grabbed ahold of Owen's left arm. During the course of this, Owen was negligently flailing his arms and struck Ofc. Singh in the chest, causing his Body Worn Camera to fall off of his uniform. Patrols then brought Owen to the ground and a struggle ensued in the street. During the struggle, I was prone out on top of Owen and was holding him down as he tried to fight officers, while Ofc. Singh had his left arm in a compliance hold. Patrols advised Owen multiple times with loud, clear commands to "Stop resisting". Owen continued to resist arrest by trying to put his arms under his body. After several minutes, Owen gave patrols his arms and he was placed in handcuffs.

Owen was then brought to his feet and sat down on the sidewalk as Ofc. Singh stood by with him. I advised Ofc. Singh to conduct a search incident of arrest of Owen's person which yielded negative results. A search of the car was continued which yielded a torn corner of a clear, plastic bag, commonly used for storing CDS. No additional items were located. All items of evidential value were placed in evidence bags and secured in my patrol vehicle. Owen was then led to my patrol vehicle and secured in the rear compartment. I then contacted Monmouth County dispatch and requested a tow to the scene. Shortly after, Boyce's Towing arrived on location and took possession of the vehicle. I then transported Owen to Police Headquarters without issue.

Once at Headquarters, Englishtown First Aid responded in reference to a knee injury sustained by Ofc. Singh, as well as lacerations and swelling on the head sustained by Owen. He refused further medical treatment after being checked by EMS. Owen was then booked and photographed in accordance with departmental policy. I charged Owen with the following on Complaint-Summons 1312S202300036:

- (1) count of 2C:29-2A(1), Resisting Arrest
- (1) count of 2C:12-1B(5)(A), Aggravated Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer
- (1) count of 2C:36-2A, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia

Additionally, Owen was issued (2) motor vehicle citations in violation of 39:3-66 and 39:4-105. Furthermore, all items of evidential value were photographed, secured in evidence

bags, and then stored in a temporary evidence locker. Owen was then released from custody and given a courtesy transport by Ofc. Singh to a convenient store. No further action taken.

Supplemental Narrative

Details of Supplemental Narrative: CDS

Date, Time, Reporting Officer 11/24/23, 00:55, Ofc. I. Singh #33

On the above date and time, I arrived on scene to a traffic stop what was being conducted by Ptl. McLearen #24 in the capacity of a back up officer. The driver of the vehicle Owen M. Sullivan was asked to step out of the vehicle by Ptl. McLearen. Mr. Sullivan explained to me that he stopped in Pennsylvania to talk to a police officer and he believes that it wasn't an actual police officer and that he was being tricked into someone stealing his car. While Ptl. McLearen was searching the vehicle Mr. Sullivan kept inching closer and closer to the vehicle and was told to step back multiple times. Even after moving back Mr. Sullivan still attempted to step closer to the vehicle. Mr. Sullivan then asked for his jacket, while I conducted a search of the jacket to make sure nothing was in side of it Ptl. McLearen found a straw containing white powdery residue in it. After this occurred I was ordered to place Mr. Sullivan in hand cuffs by Ptl. McLearen.

I then calmly and slowly asked Mr. Sullivan to place his hands behind his back multiple times. Mr. Sullivan then adjusted his hat and checked his pockets indicators of someone attempting to flee. Once Ptl. McLearen Placed his hand on Mr. Sullivan, Mr. Sullivan lunged forward and attempted to flee on foot. When this accrued I pulled Mr. Sullivan's arm towards my handcuff and pushed my hand cuff down in attempts to keep Mr. Sullivan from running any further. Mr. Sullivan was then placed on the hood of his vehicle and he still was actively resisting. Mr. Sullivan then pushed off the hood of the car, while attempting to decentralize him he was flailing his arms in such a manner to strike me in the chest and knock off my body worn camera. Mr. Sullivan was then decentralized by Ptl. McLearen and once on the floor Mr. Sullivan still attempted to resist by flailing his arms. Mr. Sullivan's arm was then placed into a compliance hold by me until he stopped resisting. At which point Ptl. McLearen placed the second hand cuff on Mr. Sullivan.

A Search was then conducted of Mr. Sullivan's Person which conducted negative. Mr. Sullivan was then taken to headquarters and processed in accordance to departmental guide lines. See Ptl. McLearen's report for further information.

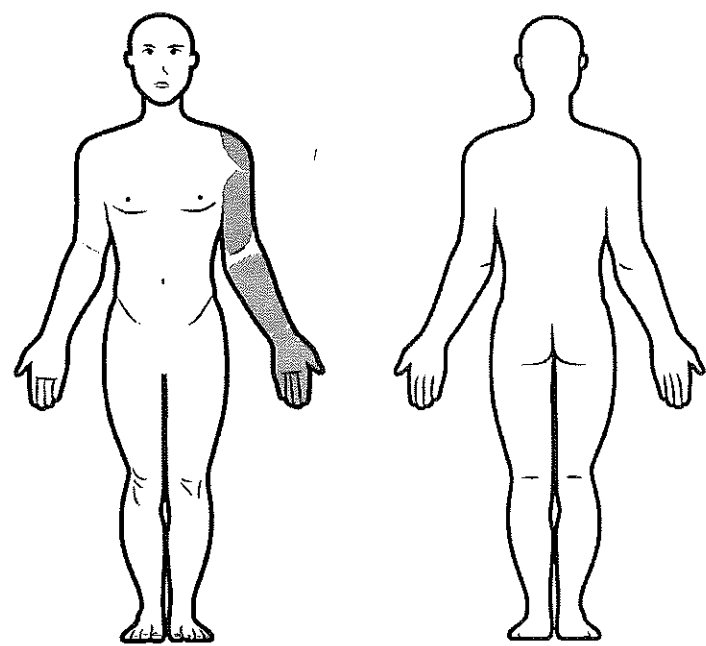

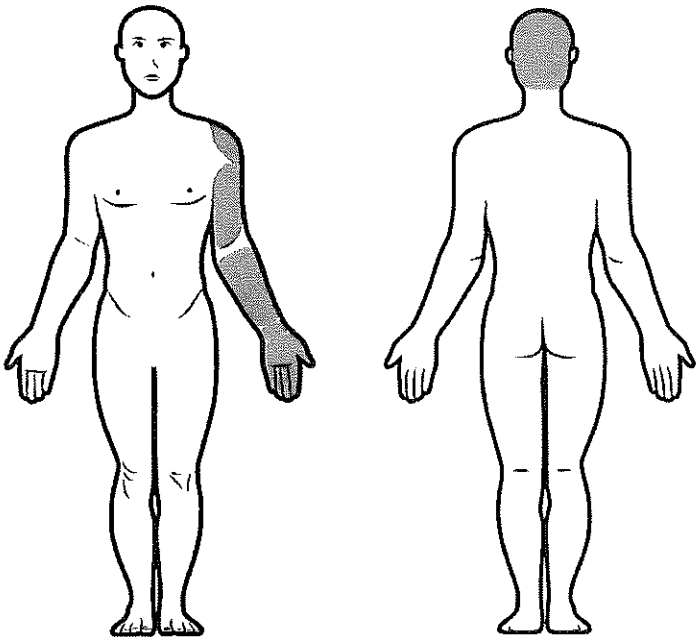
