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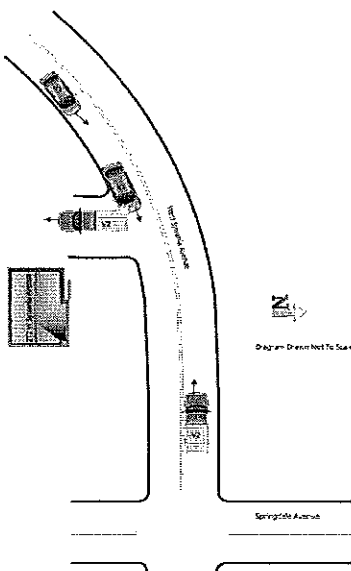

145 Crash Description/Narrative

119a: Driver 2 stated he turned into the driveway of 217 W Sylvania Avenue, and thought he had enough time to pull safely in.

Vehicle 1 was travelling east on West Sylvania Avenue. Vehicle 2 was travelling west on West Sylvania Avenue. Vehicle 2 made a left turn into the driveway of 217 West Sylvania Avenue. Vehicle 1 then collided with Vehicle 2. The front passenger side bumper of Vehicle 1 collided with the rear passenger side fender/bumper of Vehicle 2 causing damage to both vehicles. Vehicle 1 had fluid leaking from the it and was not driveable.

Both Drivers stated they were not injured and stated they did not need medical attention. After speaking with Driver 1, I requested EMS due to her being "shaken up". Neptune Township EMS arrived, and Driver 1 refused medical attention. After EMS cleared, Driver 1 exited her vehicle. After standing for several minutes, Driver 1 felt faint and started to fall. She was assisted to the ground, and I requested EMS return. Neptune Township EMS arrived, evaluated her, and transported Driver 1 to Jersey Shore University Medical Center.

Neptune City OEM was on scene and cleaned the oil spill.
