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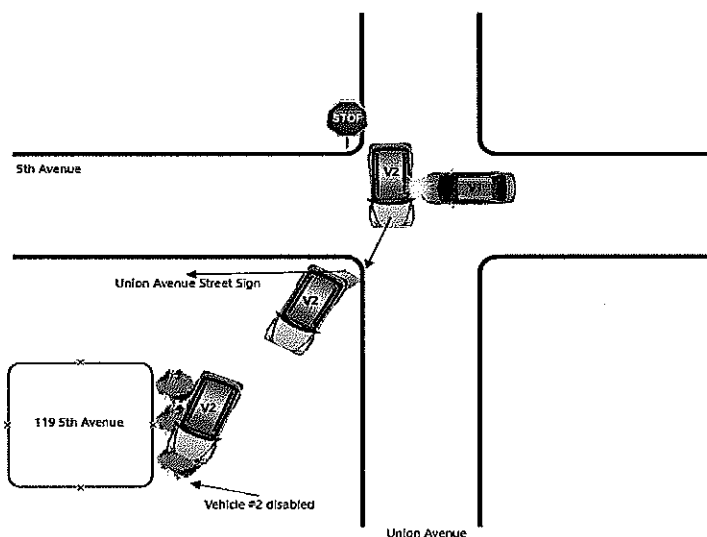

145 Crash Description/Narrative

Box 127c - Union Avenue Street Sign**Box 127d - Bushes on the property of 119 5th Avenue**

Vehicle #1 was traveling West on 5th Avenue. Vehicle #2 was traveling South on Union Avenue. The driver of Vehicle #2 stated he entered the intersection of Union Avenue and 5th Avenue after stopping at the stop sign. The driver of Vehicle #2 stated he observed no on-coming traffic when entering the intersection. The driver of Vehicle #1 stated he was traveling approximately 35mph (25mph zone) when he observed a vehicle enter the intersection. The front end of Vehicle #1 then collided with the driver side door of Vehicle #2. Vehicle #2 continued to travel South, striking a curb (Union Avenue), then a street sign (Union Avenue Street Sign), and then coming to rest in the bushes of 119 5th Avenue. Vehicle #1 became disabled in the intersection of 5th Avenue and Union Avenue and was later towed by Atlantic Coast Towing. Vehicle #2 was also disabled and later towed by Atlantic Coast Towing.

The driver of Vehicle #1 complained of pain in his knee's. The passenger of Vehicle #1 complained of pain to her head and advised she might have lost consciousness due to the collision. Both the driver and passenger of Vehicle #1 were transported to Jersey Shore University Medical Center. The driver of Vehicle #2 complained of pain to his entire body and also was in and out of consciousness due to the collision. The driver of Vehicle #1 was also transported to Jersey Shore University Medical Center.

A witness (Brianna Byrne) advised she saw the accident occur. Byrne stated Vehicle #2 stopped before entering the intersection. Byrne stated the driver of Vehicle #1 was traveling at a high rate of speed approximately 4 houses down from when Vehicle #2 entered the intersection.

Neptune City First Aid and Neptune Township First Aid and Neptune City Fire Department responded to the scene. OEM was also notified and responded for a fluid leak for Vehicle #1.
