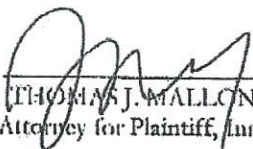

IT IS, on this _____ day of _____, 201____,

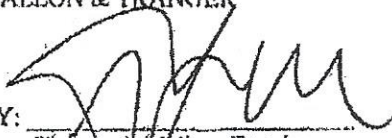
ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

3. Counts Three, Four and Six of Plaintiff, Inna DiPeso's Complaint are hereby dismissed with prejudice.
4. Count Two of Plaintiff, Inna DiPeso's Complaint is hereby dismissed with prejudice with the exception of the respondeat superior claim against Defendant, Borough of Seaside Heights.
5. The punitive damages prayers for relief in Counts Two, Three and Five of Plaintiff, Sophia DiPeso's Complaint are hereby withdrawn.
6. The punitive damages prayers for relief in Counts One and Two of Plaintiff, Inna DiPeso's Complaint are hereby withdrawn.
7. Plaintiffs, Sophia DiPeso and Inna DiPeso, are hereby withdrawing all of their requests for attorney's fees from their respective Complaints.
