- 2nd Call:**
1. Activate “Fanwood EMS” page wait 2 minutes.
 2. If two members do not call in set off a 2nd page Using “Fanwood EMS”.
 3. If after 2 additional minutes two members still do not call in dispatch Mutual Aid per CAD recommendation.
- 3rd Calls:**
1. Dispatch mutual aid per CAD recommendation.
- ALS Calls:**
1. Primary ALS is Mercy (Med Central) then Medic 1(MONOC) then Medic 9 or10 then Medic 2(MONOC).

MUTUAL AID TO SURROUND TOWNS

NO mutual aid to Plainfield except for MCI's.

They will respond to all other towns for mutual aid 24/7.

FIRE CALLS

Fanwood Rescue Squad should be paged out for any working fires, smoke condition or at the request of the FD.

On behalf of the officers of the Fanwood Rescue Squad, we would like to move FRS's responses away from the scramble system and to only being paged/toned when members call in service with a full crew ahead of time. Effectively, our paging would be similar to SPRS of only being toned when present. I've encouraged my members to focus on nights and weekends. I do expect some still to respond to from home, but again only if we have an established crew to prevent the dispatch delays prior to mutual aid.

With regards to off-duty time, please keep the same response plan as is where Union County EMS is the primary backup for the borough of Fanwood up to a 10 minute ETA. If UCEMS is not available, we'd like to prioritize SPRS volunteers if they are in service, but if not, next closest available is fine.

My hope is that this change can be effective for February 1st, 2026 please.

The Fanwood Rescue Squad will no longer respond to calls unless they have a crew on duty. The squads ambulances should be kept off duty unless someone from the squad calls into dispatch and reports they have a crew in service. They will advise what ambulance they will be operating out of and also what time they will be in service till. There is no change to coverage in the town Monday - Friday during the day where the County is the primary agency. If the squad is not in service do an initial assignment and the CAD will pick the appropriate agency to respond. In most cases this will be a County EMS unit.

Dear Dispatch Personnel,

The following information is to assist with general operation and knowledge of Union County EMS, our shifts, ambulances, and posting. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to reach out to brian.downing@ucnj.org.

Weekdays:

6 Ambulances at peak- 4 of them 7a-7p (A1, A2, A8, A10), one each at 9a-5p (A4), 10a-6p (A5) – more ambulances dependent on volume/recall/MCI at discretion of EMS supervisor.
3 Ambulances night shift – A7, A9, A11
Optional – A6 usually 6p-12a; A3 extra flexible-hour dayshift ambulance
Special Events – A12, A13, A14, A15

Weekends:

4 Ambulances daytime (1, 2, 8, 10), 3 at night (7, 9, 11) with an optional A6.

Postings:

Westfield – 400 North Ave E. – A1, A2 (A7) – Usually the hazmat tech crews
Plainfield – 1050 South Ave – PFD Engine 4 firehouse – A10/A11
Roselle Park – 535 Laurel Ave – A8/A9 (A4 or A5 as backup weekdays to supplement)
Fanwood – 75 N. Martine Ave – Fanwood Fire – A4 or A5 for powershift coverage
Other posts possible at discretion of EMS Management and county need; soft posting likely during MCIs.

Coverages:

Roselle Park 24/7
Plainfield 24/7 – EMD done by JFK – UCEMS PRIMARY FOR ALL STRUCTURE FIRES
Fanwood M-F 6a-6p, primary backup to FRS all other times
New Providence – M, T, Th, F 7a-7p (subject to mild changes from their leadership)
Clark – Primary 2nd due to CVRS
Westfield – Primary 2nd due to WRS
Kenilworth – Primary 2nd due to KFD EMS
Mountainside – Primary 2nd due to MRS/AtEMS8
Backup to every other UC municipality as needed/requested. Other obligations/contracts TBD on an as-need basis.

For Internal Use Only

All Ambulances are regional and can be pulled from their primary coverage territory as needed. Any corresponding questions about operations can be directed to the on-duty supervisor or EMS Captain.

Notes About Plainfield City:

- 911 call goes to Plainfield Police who transfers to JFK for EMD.
- JFK determines closest unit base off of the Genesis Pulse Map (JFK entity).
- UC EMS Supervisor is instructed to roster UC Ambulances with JFK each morning and evening.
- JFK will call UC dispatch for an ambulance as needed.
- In the event of a fire or major assignment for PFD, A10/A11 may ride out on it behind the FD and will call in the assignment to UC Dispatch. Please build the card accordingly, and a UC Supervisor will respond as well.
- UCEMS is primary BLS response for ALL structure fires in Plainfield regardless of location.
- Please see Brian Downing with any issues regarding JFK/UCEMS/Plainfield relationship.

Out of County Mutual Aid

- Out of County mutual aid approval should go through the on-duty EMS supervisor, but in general any ALS request to a bordering municipality with at least three UC ambulances available should be approved. All others are at the discretion of the supervisor.
