Until I received the shared service agreements from Mr. Smith, I was not aware of it's content. They were not provided to me by SBFD3 or their attorney when requested.

If you believe additional information would benefit FTFD4's alignment with SBFD2's objectives, please share it with me for presentation to the board.

Mr. McParland,

In response to your latest email, dated 8-5-2024, South Brunswick Township Fire District No. 2 provides the following information for clarification, after discussion with our attorney, Richard M. Braslow.

First, we will reiterate that South Brunswick Township Fire District No. 2 does not possess any records other than which has already been provided concerning Franklin Township Fire District No. 4.

As you mention, Section 7 of the Shared Services Agreement between the three South Brunswick Township Fire Districts specifically states that Fire District No. 3 shall be responsible for the administrative details regarding the per diem staff, including payroll. It is further the responsibility of Fire District No. 3 to submit invoices to Fire District No. 1 & No. 2 for the associated costs of the per diem staff. As of the writing of this email, the municipality of South Brunswick Township, which processes the payroll for all three fire districts, has not provided the second quarter payroll invoices. As such, Fire District No. 3 has not provided invoices to Fire District No. 1 or No. 2. Fire District No. 2 does not maintain records of the per diem staff, as again, this is the responsibility of Fire District No. 3, so it is impossible for our district to provide such records. Please contact Fire District No. 3 for these records and any potential discrepancy that you allude to.

Also as you mention, Section 16 of the Shared Services Agreement states that the Fire Chiefs shall make decisions for mutual aid requests outside of South Brunswick Township or Franklin Township Fire District No. 4. This agreement honors the agreement between South Brunswick Township Fire District No. 3 and Franklin Township Fire District No. 4 for coverage of emergency calls. It is understood by all three South Brunswick Fire Districts

that the daytime staff coverage shall respond automatically into Franklin Township Fire District No. 4 when the crew is on duty.

In response to your comment requesting clarification of our interpretation of OPRA, we cannot make it any clearer that South Brunswick Township Fire District No. 2 has provided all records to the requesting party as they pertain to Franklin Township Fire District No. 4. There should be no further question or confusion on this matter as we have met the statutory requirements of OPRA. Records simply cannot be provided if they do not exist.

Lastly, we request that any future correspondence regarding OPRA requests as they pertain to Franklin Township Fire District No. 4 should be directed to our attorney, Richard M. Braslow. He can be reached via email at braslowesq6@gmail.com. Mr. Braslow will respond to any future OPRA requests on behalf of South Brunswick Township Fire District No. 2.

Thank you for your response (August 5, 2024) to my Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request dated July 30, 2024.

While I acknowledge your statement that South Brunswick Township Fire District #2 (SBFD2) does not have the requested invoices for services provided to SBFD3, I would like to clarify a potential discrepancy based on the shared services agreement you previously provided (attached).

Section 7 of the agreement entered into by SBFD2, dated March 26, 2024, outlines the process for billing per-diem staff costs to all three districts. To ensure transparency and accurate financial records, I would appreciate it if you could confirm whether SBFD2 maintains any records related to per-diem staffing, even if not directly invoiced to FTFD4.

Furthermore, Section 16 of the same agreement references decision-making by fire chiefs regarding mutual aid requests outside of South Brunswick Township or Franklin Township Fire District 4. This section appears to suggest a potential role for SBFD2 in such situations.

Therefore, I would be grateful if you could clarify SBFD2's involvement, if any, in mutual aid responses related to FTFD4.

Finally, I understand your position that SBFD2 has no formal obligation to provide fire protection services to FTFD4.

However, under OPRA, public entities are generally required to provide access to records regardless of the specific contractual relationship between the requesting party and the governing body.

Therefore, I would appreciate Mr. Braslow's assistance in clarifying SBFD2's interpretation of OPRA as it relates to my request for records related to per-diem staffing and potential involvement in mutual aid responses for FTFD4.

Dear Mr. Smith,

Thank you for your response dated July 29th. While I appreciate the documents provided regarding the shared services agreement, they raise further questions concerning the service arrangements between South Brunswick Fire Districts and Franklin Township Fire District 4 (FTFD4).

The contracts and notes you've supplied differ significantly from the determination of funding SBFD3 seeks from FTFD4 for fire services delivered through the Kingston Volunteer Fire Company #1 (KVFC1). This discrepancy necessitates further clarification to ensure transparency for all districts and taxpayers involved.

To facilitate a more comprehensive understanding, I've attached a copy of South Brunswick Fire District 3's approved 2024/2025 budget. This document highlights substantial increases in several line items compared

to the previous year's contract with FTFD4. These increases were presented to FTFD4 as the cost structure for our district to continue services, but were presented without the context of the shared service agreements you provided, which reveal a substantial difference in cost and resource allocations.

Additionally, the provided notes and contracts, previously undisclosed to FTFD4, suggest SBD3 anticipated cost reductions through agreements with SBD1 and SBD2 prior to presenting substantial increases to FTFD4. This includes a reduction in staff previously allocated to serve FTFD4 through the KVFC1, which has translated into significant increases in staff expenses and related costs demanded of FTFD4 this fiscal year.

FTFD4 remains a small district without a dedicated fire department. Our historical contribution has been a fixed percentage (10% ratable over specific firematic service line items) to facilitate KVFC1 services for our residents. As previously communicated, FTFD4 voted against renewing the shared

services agreement with SBD3 due to several factors, including those outlined above.

To clarify these matters and promote transparency, I request the following additional information under OPRA:

- Invoices from SBD3 to SBD2 from March 1st of this year to date under the shared services agreement you provided
- Correspondences indicating your knowledge that FTFD4 was expected to subsidize resources for SBFD3 that are now also and additionally being paid for by SBFD2 and SBFD1
- Correspondences indicating your knowledge that FTFD4 was expected to subsidize resources for SBFD3 at the KVFC1 that were then removed from the KVFC1 and mostly placed at SBFD2 and SBFD1
- Communications between SBFD2 and SBFD3 regarding a

potential service denial
to FTFD4 as stated in
the email below.

I remain hopeful for
continued negotiations to
establish a mutually
beneficial agreement that
prioritizes the needs of the
Kingston Volunteer Fire
Company #1. Given SBD3's
demand for payment and
response (for transparency-
attached below),
please confirm SBFD2's
commitment to providing
emergency mutual aid
to FTFD4 while we continue
to try to procure an
agreement for our district.

Attached, please find the invoice for contracted fire services from January to June 2024. The invoice amount is \$29,764, based on the current agreement and agreed-upon extension. A copy of the invoice will also be sent to you via US mail.

Due to Franklin Fire District 4's failure to accept all previous and the most recent versions of the negotiated terms, South Brunswick Fire District 3 has decided to end negotiations. This email serves as formal notice to FD4 that SB3 will no longer be providing fire protection services effective August 31, 2024. The additional months of July and August will be billed according to the current agreement terms of \$4,960.67 per month. If additional time is required to seek contract services and is approved by the SB3 Board, FD4 will be responsible for the same monthly amount of \$4,960.67.

SB3 is disappointed that the latest mutually agreed-upon terms created by representatives from both boards were once again rejected by FD4. We wish FD4 the best in securing fire protection coverage for their district.
