

EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT

Township of Lawrence and New Jersey American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 73, AFL-CIO, Local 2257

THIS AGREEMENT made this 12 day of November 2020 by and between the *Township of Lawrence*, a municipal corporation of the State of New Jersey, having its principal offices at 2207 Lawrence Road, Lawrence Township, New Jersey 08648 ("Township") and *New Jersey American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Council 73, AFL-CIO, Local 2257*, having its principal offices at Nottingham Village Square, 2653A Whitehorse-Hamilton Square Road, Hamilton, NJ 08690 ("Union").

WITNESS

WHEREAS, the Township and the Union entered into an Employment Agreement dated May 2, 2017, to establish "the complete and final understanding on all bargaining issues between the Township and the Union" for three years commencing on January 1, 2017, through December 31, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Township and the Union did initiate negotiations for a new employment contract at a time just before the worldwide health crisis involving the spread of a novel coronavirus more commonly known as Covid-19 ("Pandemic"); and

WHEREAS, the Parties understand and agree that the negotiations could not meaningfully continue while the negative impact of the Pandemic persists with no identifiable end date; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now wish to extend the prior Employment Agreement, with modifications, for an additional two-year period ending December 31, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the legal sufficiency is hereby acknowledged. The Parties agree as follows:

1. Term of Agreement: The prior negotiated employment agreement (attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A) is extended from December 31, 2019, to December 31, 2021.

2. Base salaries: Salaries for all covered employees and all Step Schedules under the existing employment agreement shall be increased as follows: 2020 – 2.0% and 2021 – 2.0%. The revised Salary Schedules are attached as Exhibit B.

3. Holidays: Section 8.2 is amended to include Juneteenth (June 19) as an observed holiday by the Township of Lawrence.

4. Bereavement Leave. Section 12.1 shall be changed as follows:

"...or in the case of spouse or child, in which case said leave shall not exceed fifteen (15) consecutive working days per incident."

5. Health Benefits: Section 15.5 shall be changed as follows:

"The Township will pay for a life insurance policy in the amount of seven thousand five hundred (\$7,500) dollars for natural death and will increase to twelve thousand five hundred (\$12,500) dollars in the event of accidental death. The Township reserves the right to choose the insurance carrier for this program."

6. Extended Sick Leave: Article XVII, Section 17.1 shall be modified as follows:

"(a) All permanent employees or full-time provisional employees shall be entitled to sick leave with pay based on their aggregate years of service; (b) Sick leave may be utilized by employees in accordance with NJSA 4A:6-1.3g; and (c) The Family and Medical Leave Act of 1993 and/or The New Jersey Family Leave Act provisions will govern as applicable."

7. Clothing Allowance: Section 28.1 shall be changed as follows:

"The Township agrees to provide the following Employees additional income for the cost of uniforms:

- 1) \$275 for Public Health Nurses;
- 2) \$675 for Animal Control Officers;
- 3) \$375 for Housing Inspector;
- 4) \$375 for Recreation Leader;
- 5) \$575 for Fire Protection Sub-Code official;
- 6) \$375 for Public Works Inspector, Registered Environmental Health Specialist, and Building Inspectors.

This payment shall be paid as additional income to the Employee by no later than the last day in January of each year of this Agreement. This payment is not pensionable.

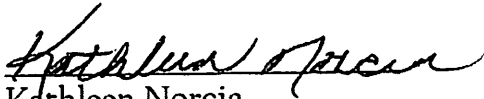
8. Modification: This Agreement contains the Parties' entire understanding concerning the subject matter hereof. It may not be changed or modified orally, but only by duly authorized written instruments signed by the Parties.

9. Validity and Enforceability: Each party waives all rights to challenge the validity or enforceability of this Agreement.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have duly executed this Agreement as of the day and year first written.

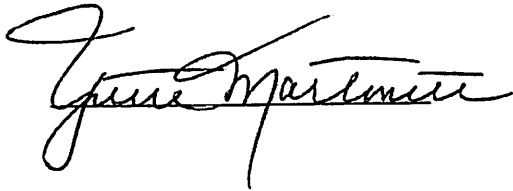
