Mr. Dirt:

The Township of Tabernacle received your Open Public Records Act (OPRA) request on May 21, 2022. The official Records Custodian, Everett Falt, received your OPRA request on May 23, 2022. As such, the seven (7) business day deadline to respond to your request is June 2, 2022. A request for clarification was provided to you on the 6th business day after the custodian's receipt of said request. This correspondence is being provided to you on the 7th business day following the custodian's receipt.

You requested the following records: "A list of all drivers reported to the joint insurance fund for TRS, the Tabernacle Fire Company, and the Department of Public Works." In a follow up email, you requested: "I will take the list of all members covered under JIF." If you would like the employees as well, please do let me know.

The following records are being provided in their entirety and are responsive to your request:

1. 2021 Resolution with a list of members of the Fire Department.
2. 2021 Resolution with a list of members of the Tabernacle Rescue Squad.
3. 2022 Resolution with a list of members of the OEM Cert Team.
4. List of all employees reported to the JIF.
5. Correspondence from the Joint Insurance Fund.

These records are being transmitted to you via opra+request-32121-8931ba0c@requests.opramachine.com, as per your request. If your request for access to a government record has been denied or unfilled within the seven (7) business days required by law, you have a right to challenge the decision by the Township of Tabernacle to deny access. At your option, you may either institute a proceeding in the Superior Court of New Jersey or file a complaint with the Government Records Council (GRC) by completing the Denial of Access Complaint Form. You may contact the GRC by toll-free telephone at 866-850-0511, by mail at P.O. Box 819, Trenton, NJ, 08625, by e-mail at grc@dca.state.nj.us, or at their web site at www.state.nj.us/grc. The GRC can also answer other questions about the law. All questions regarding complaints filed in Superior Court should be directed to the Court Clerk in your County.
