Education Services -

As a part of an effort to keep students updated regarding substance abuse within the **Township of Piscataway, NJ** area and its impact on children achievement, Douglas S. Collier, M.A., DEA (Ret.) and Monmouth University, Department of Criminal Justice- Graduate Professor, has customized two education prevention and outreach trainings that can be provided to students of Piscataway Township.

The title: "It's Just Marijuana" - Informing our teens, the reality of marijuana uses during their adolescent years. This program will address the topic of marijuana use among adolescents. Some research has shown that states in which Marijuana has been legalized have seen significant increases in use among youth. This increased use brings with it significant increases in health concerns for our minors.

The title: Beyond - "The Smoke Screen" - What our kids need to know about the Vapes, Puffs, E-cigs, Juuls, and Cloud Pens... This program will address the topic of Vapes/Puffs and the risk factors associated with vaping which is linked to high use rates of other drugs and risk factors among adolescents.
